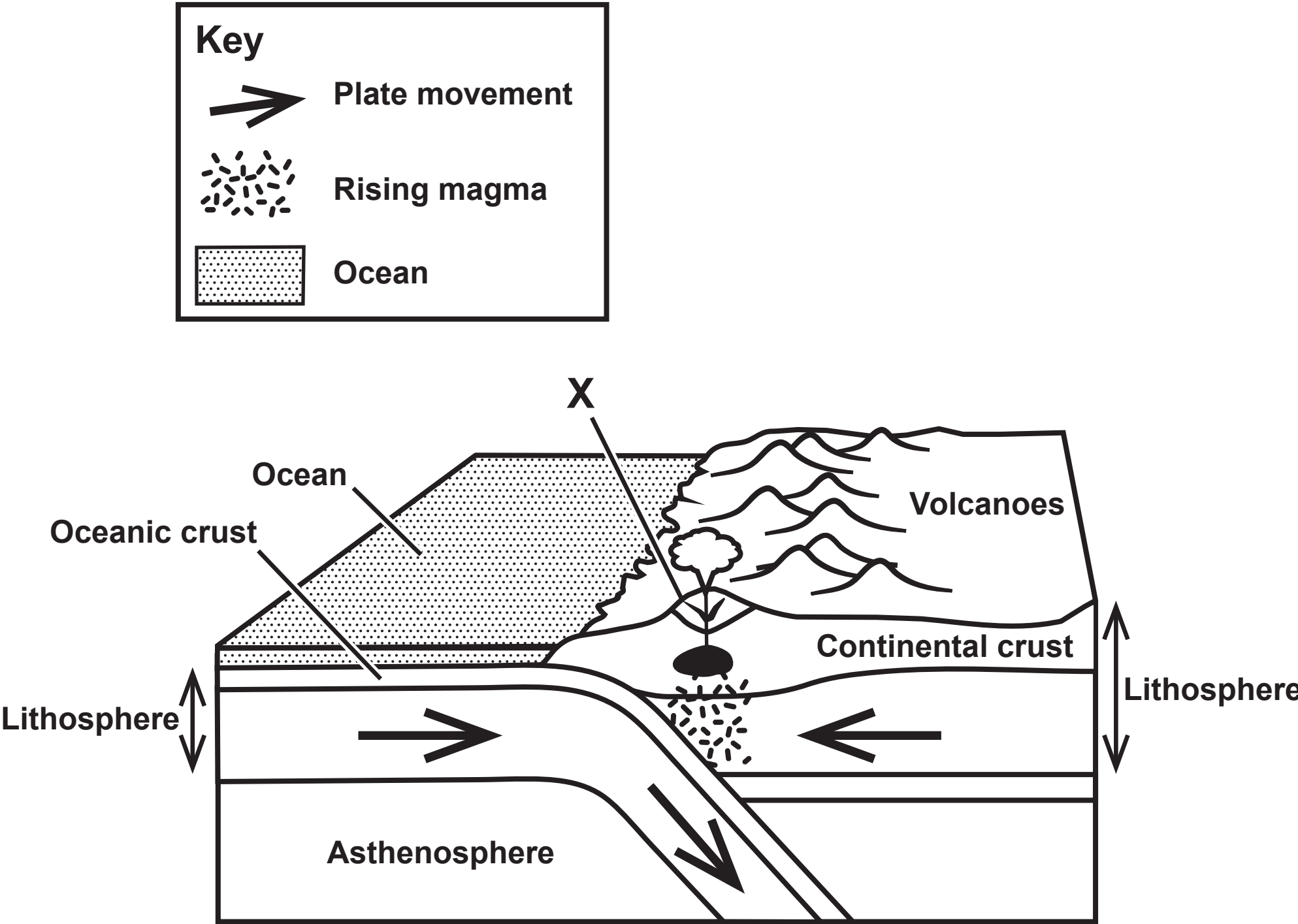


Figure 1 – Top and Side View



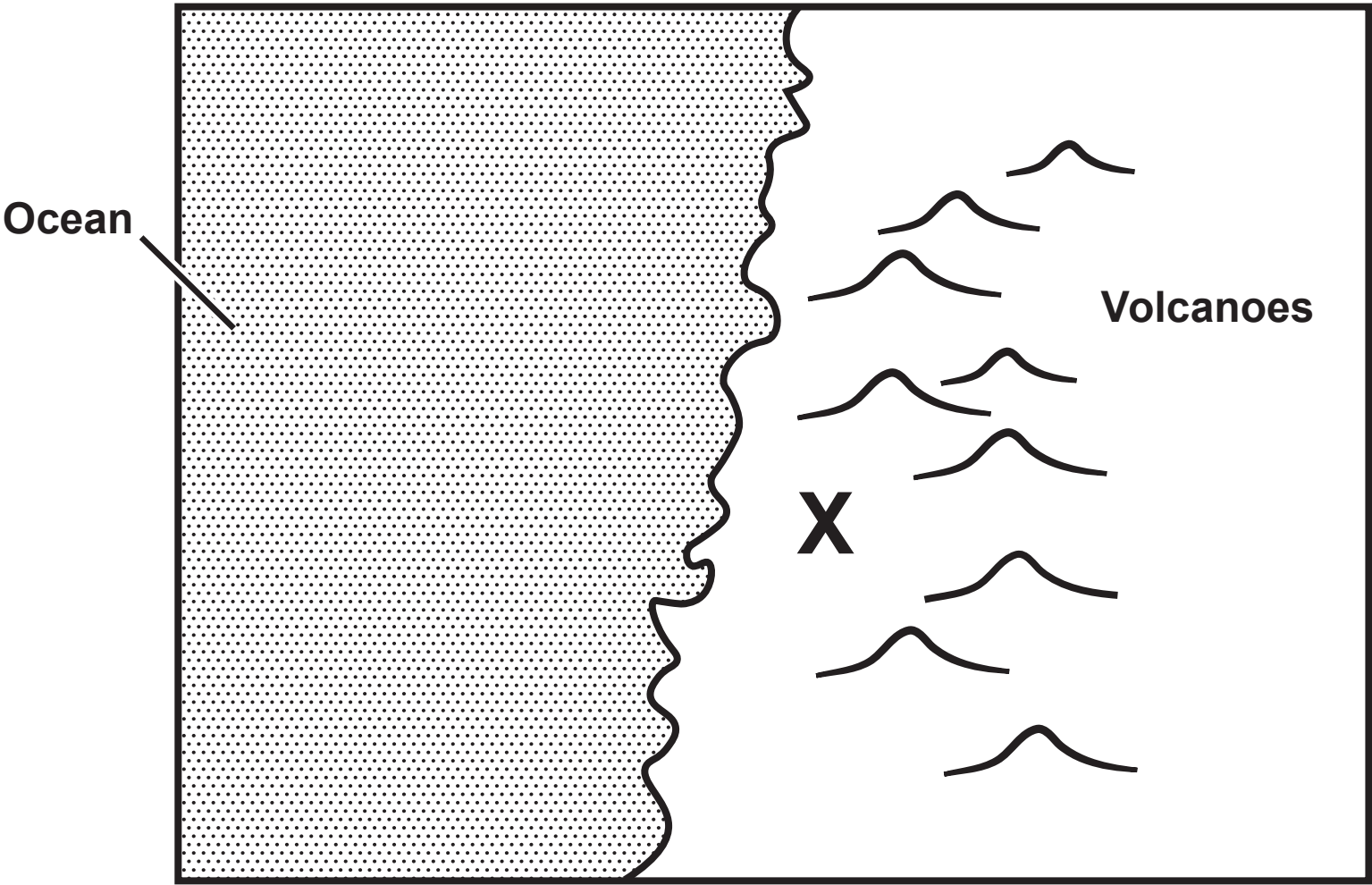


Rising magma

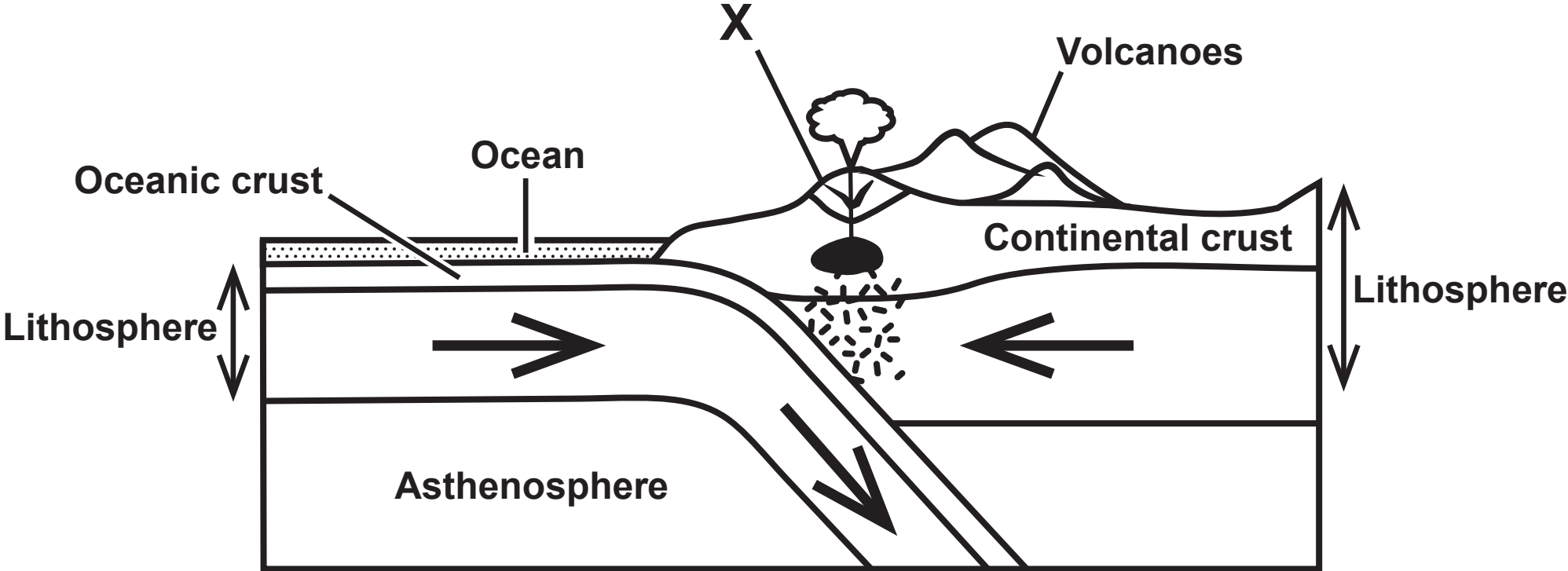

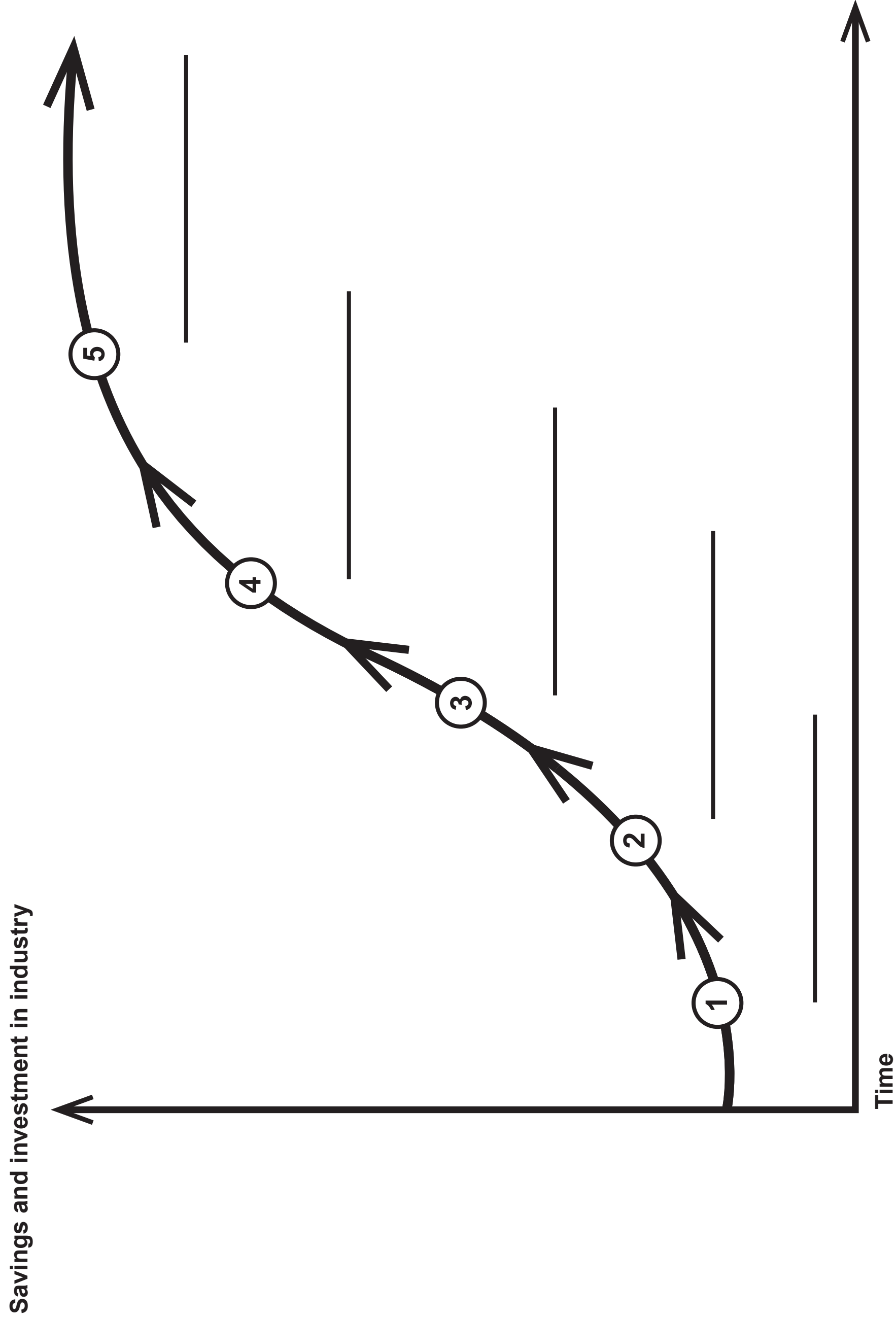

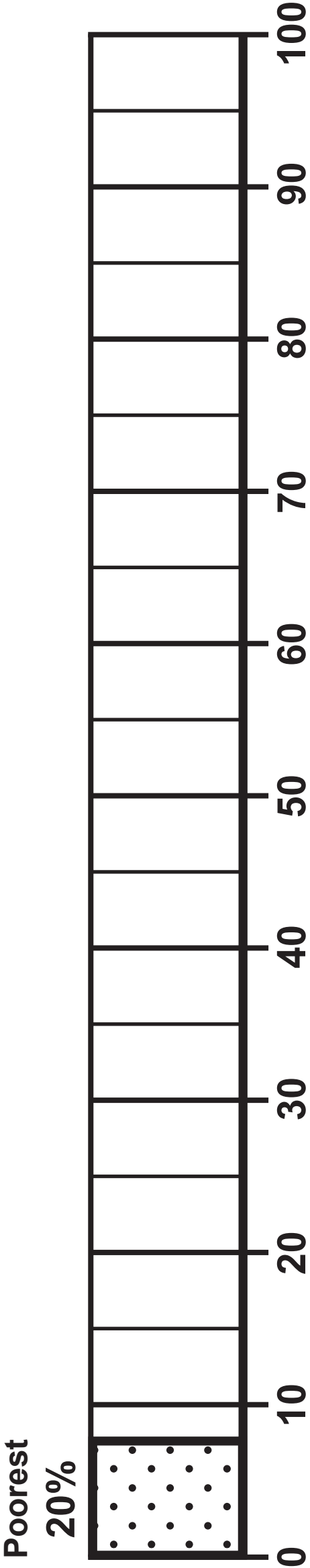

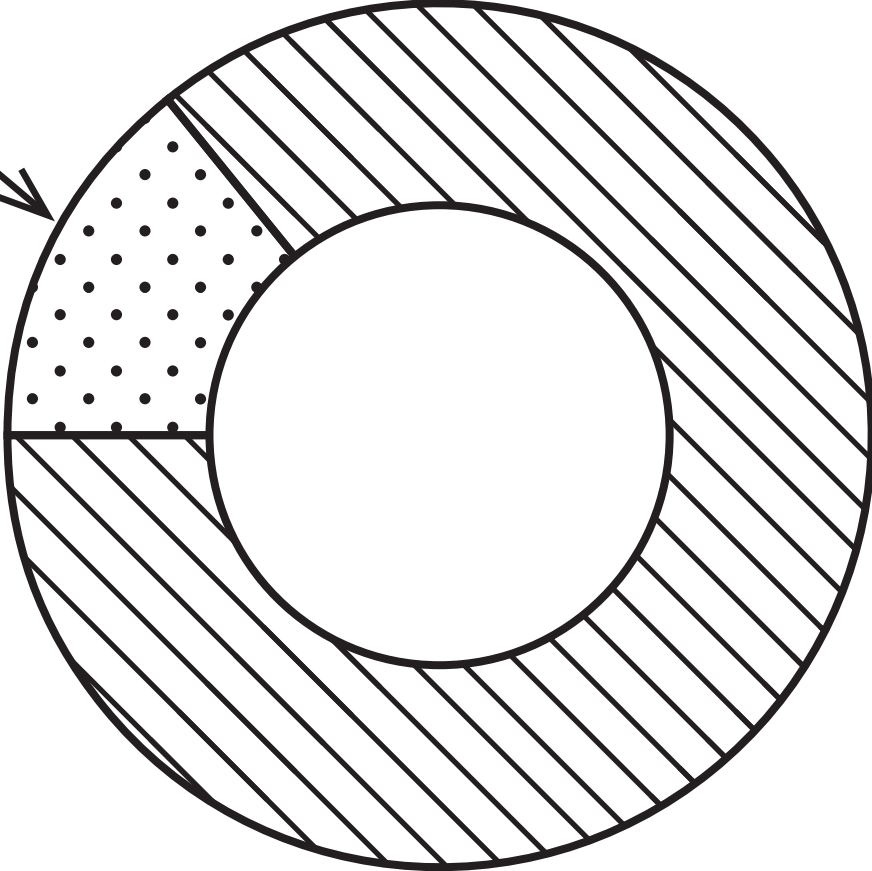

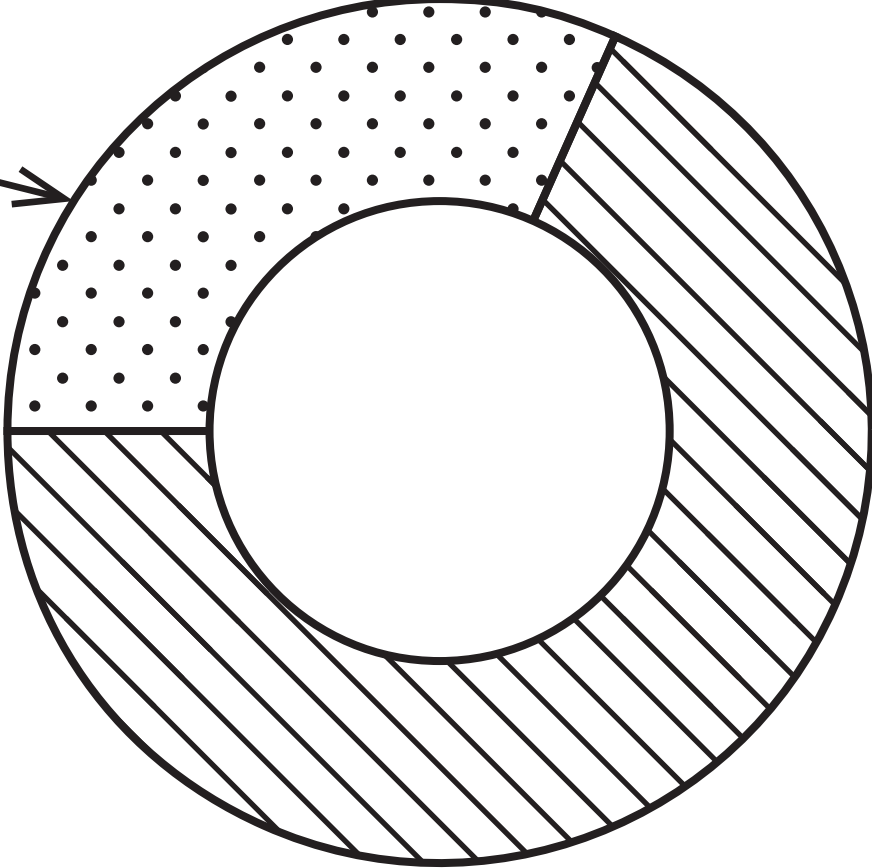

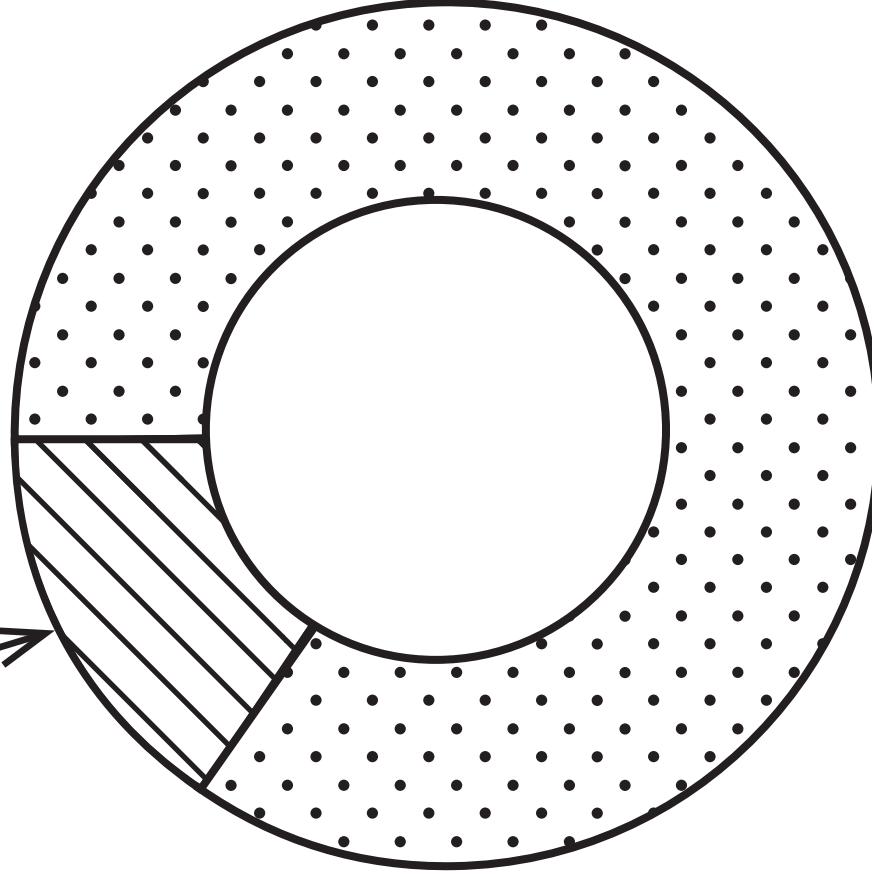

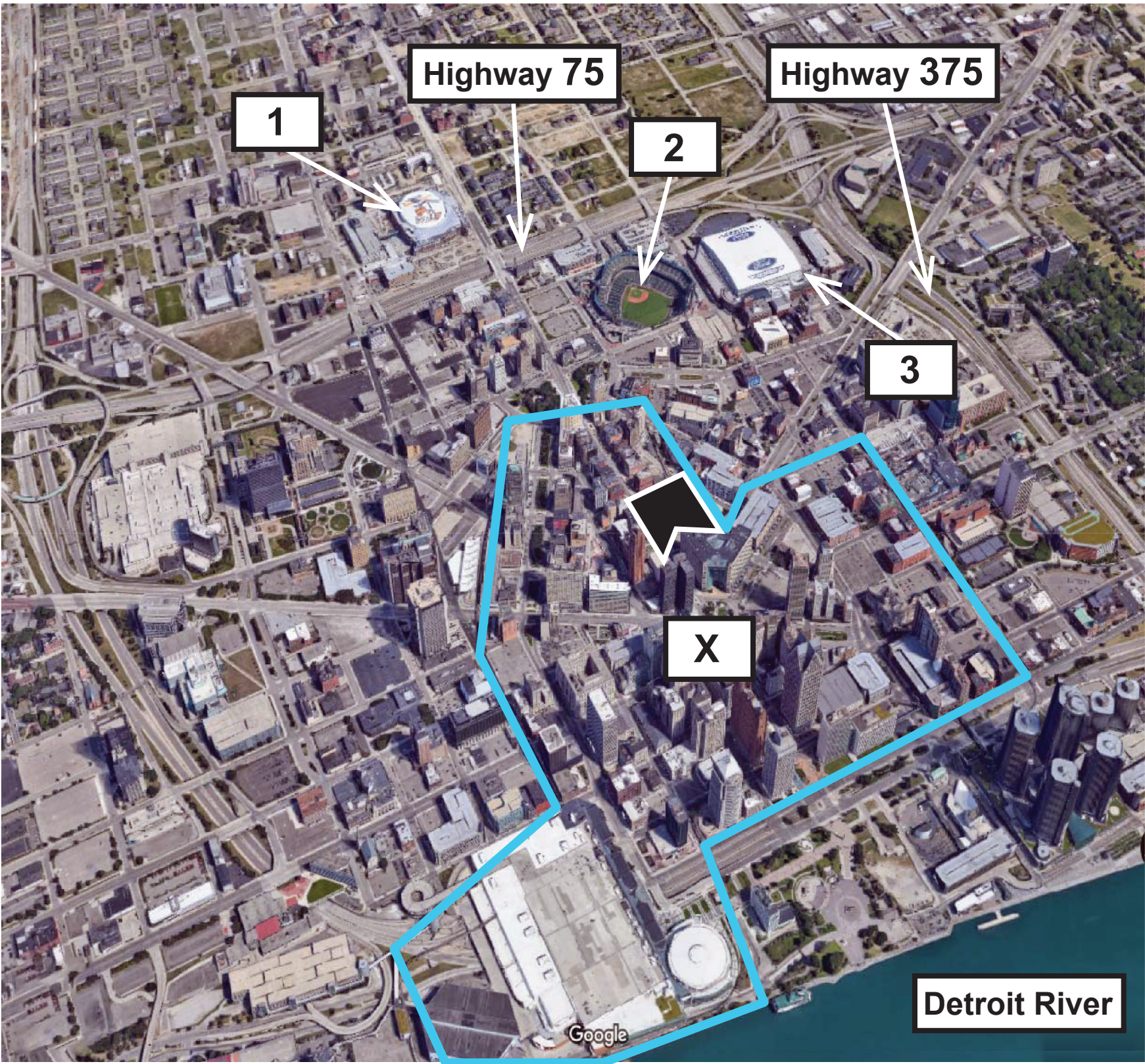
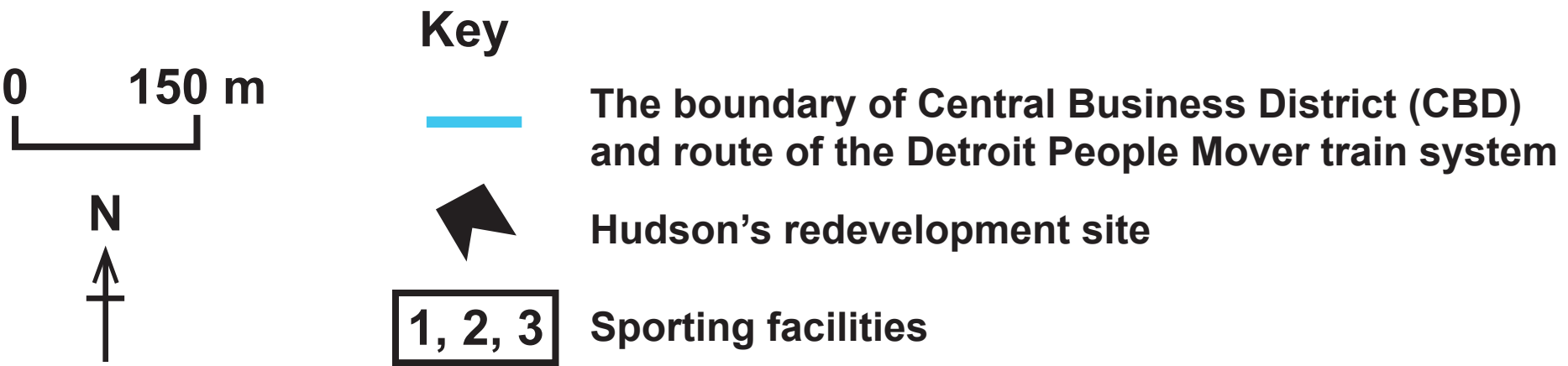


Figure 9 – Black and White
