4(b)	<p>Accept: They have relatives/family <u>there</u> To meet/see/visit relatives/family</p> <p>Reject: To visit their father They have friends and family To see friends and family They have relatives/family</p>	(1)

4(c)	<p>Accept: Barbeque (1 mark) on the beach (1 mark) For two marks, the two individual elements have to be <u>connected</u> Grilled food (1) The beach(es) (1)</p> <p>Reject: Having a barbeque (1) then going on the beach (0), this will only gain one mark for the first element</p> <p>If wrong information is included in the answer beyond the two correct elements, deduct one mark for this, e.g. Having barbeques on the beach, learning Australian = one mark</p>	(2)

4(d)	<p>Accept: Homework (from school) Exercises, tasks from <u>school</u> School Work</p> <p>Reject: Work (on its own) Information from the school</p>	(1)

4(e)	<p>Accept: Stay in touch with <u>friends</u> (1 mark) in Germany (1 mark) To (stay in) contact (with) friends (1 mark)</p> <p>Reject: To chat with friends</p> <p>If wrong information is included in the answer beyond the two correct elements, deduct one mark for this, e.g. to contact a friend in Germany , he was told to = 1 mark</p>	(2)
