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Information

The tasks must be completed under controlled conditions. 22.5 hours is **suggested** for report writing. This does **not** include any time spent on research and investigation.

- All work must be completed under direct supervision.
- The candidate is allowed to access information and resources determined by the teacher during their research.
- Candidates are also allowed to work in groups. The teacher will have to ensure that the contributions of individual candidates are recorded accurately.

Controlled Assessment Tasks

In this unit you need to produce evidence based on an investigation into the needs of **one** service user and how these needs are met. Your service user should be chosen from one of the following service user groups.

Either

- early years

or

- care of older people

As part of your investigation you will need to complete the following tasks:

Task 1

Write a report that provides the following:

- a description of the range of services provided by your chosen service provider including the main service and additional services
- a brief description of the three sectors that provide health and social care, identifying the relevant sector for your chosen service provider
- **two** examples of multi-agency workers who work with your chosen service provider to provide care services
- an explanation of how the multi-agency workers communicate with each other to ensure client needs are met
- an explanation of the difference between universal services and targeted services.

Task 2

Select **one** service user who accesses your chosen service provider. For your chosen service user describe the following:

- the reason(s) why your service user accesses the service provision
- the current physical, intellectual, emotional and social needs of the service user
- how the service provider meets those needs
- the different methods of referral to care services and how your service user was referred
- the range of potential barriers when accessing care services. Identify those barriers that your service user may encounter.

Task 3

Choose **two** care workers, **one** providing direct care and **one** providing indirect care for your chosen service user.

- Create job descriptions for both care workers which include the qualifications and the essential and desirable skills required for the job roles.
- Provide a brief description of what the job roles will involve.

Use both primary and secondary sources of information when completing this task.

Task 4

Using examples, explain how your care workers implement the care values when caring for your chosen service user.

Task 5

From your research, evaluate how effective the service provider is in minimising the barriers to accessing care services. Provide some **realistic** suggestions of what the service provider could do to further improve access to the services.
