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## Information

The tasks must be completed under controlled conditions. 22.5 hours is **suggested** for report writing. This does **not** include any time spent on research and investigation.

- All work must be completed under direct supervision.
- The candidate is allowed to access information and resources determined by the teacher during their research.
- Candidates are also allowed to work in groups. The teacher will have to ensure that the contributions of individual candidates are recorded accurately.

## Controlled Assessment Tasks

In this unit you need to produce evidence based on an investigation into the needs of **ONE** service user and how these needs are met by a **specific service provider**. Your service user should be chosen from **ONE** of the following service user groups.

Either

- Health

or

- Early Years

As part of your investigation you will need to complete the following tasks:

### Task 1

Produce a case study of your chosen service user which includes the following:

- a description of your service user and the service provider he/she accesses
- an explanation of the main reasons why your service user accesses the service provider
- a description of the range of referral methods and the way your chosen service user was referred to the service provider
- a description of a range of barriers which may prevent access to the service provider, identifying any barriers specific to your service user
- a description of the current physical, intellectual, emotional and social needs of your service user
- a description of how a failure to meet these needs may affect the development of the service user.

## Task 2

For your chosen service provider describe the following:

- the sector within which the service provider sits
- the full range of services provided
- how these services help to meet your service user's needs
- any services which have been outsourced to other companies or agencies.

## Task 3

For your chosen service provider explain how it is organised and fits into the local and national framework.

## Task 4

Choose **two direct care** workers who help to meet the needs of your chosen service user. For both workers describe:

- their key roles within the organisation
- the skills and qualifications they require
- the full range of Care Values
- how they would apply the following care values to their chosen service user:
  - Confidentiality
  - Effective communication
  - Anti-discriminatory practice.

## Task 5

From your research, evaluate how effective the service provider is in meeting the needs of your service user. Make some realistic suggestions of how the service provision could be improved.
