## How to answer the question

1 (a) Describe **one** feature of education in early Elizabethan England.

1. Identify a **feature**. For example, boys from wealthy families educated at home, grammar schools available for boys of gentry and yeoman families.
2. Add a sentence of **additional information** that is linked to the feature.

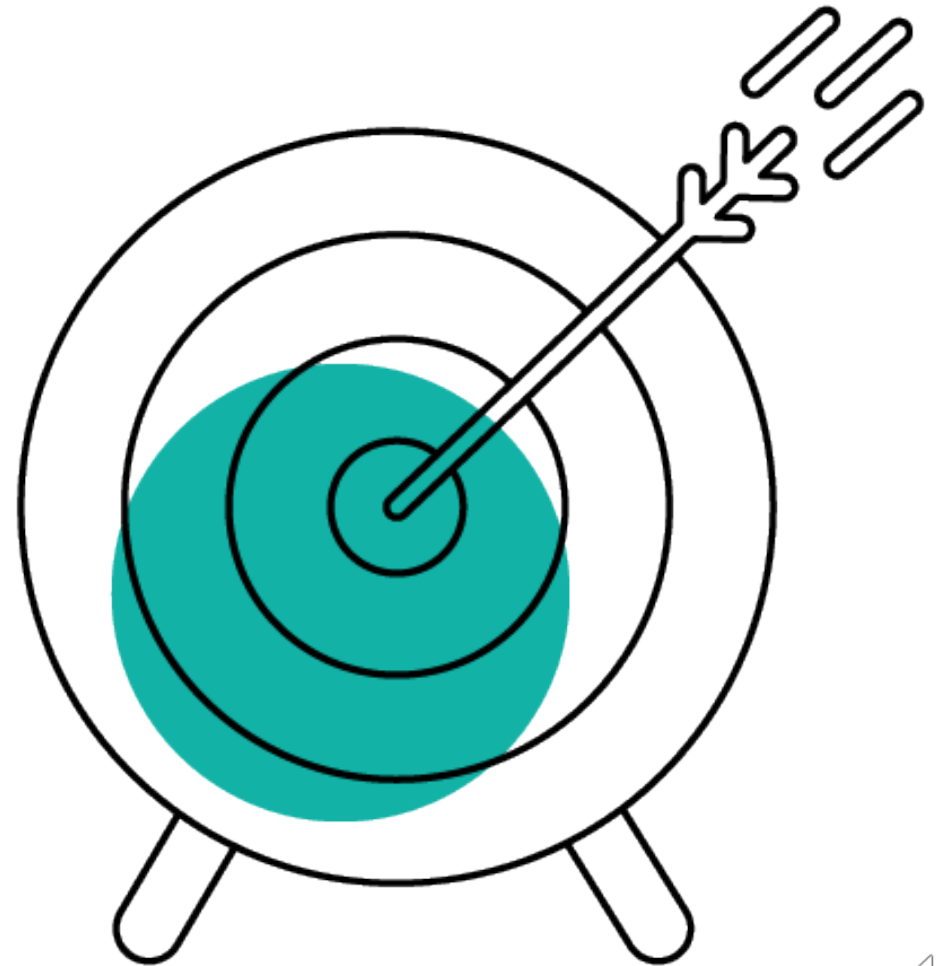
- **Try to write just two sentences.**
