# Foundation Tier Formulae Sheet

## Perimeter, area and volume

Where **a** and **b** are the lengths of the parallel sides and **h** is their perpendicular separation:

$$\text{Area of a trapezium} = \frac{1}{2}(a + b)h$$

Volume of a prism =  
area of cross section  $\times$  length

Perimeter, area and volume continued.

Where  $r$  is the radius and  $d$  is the diameter:

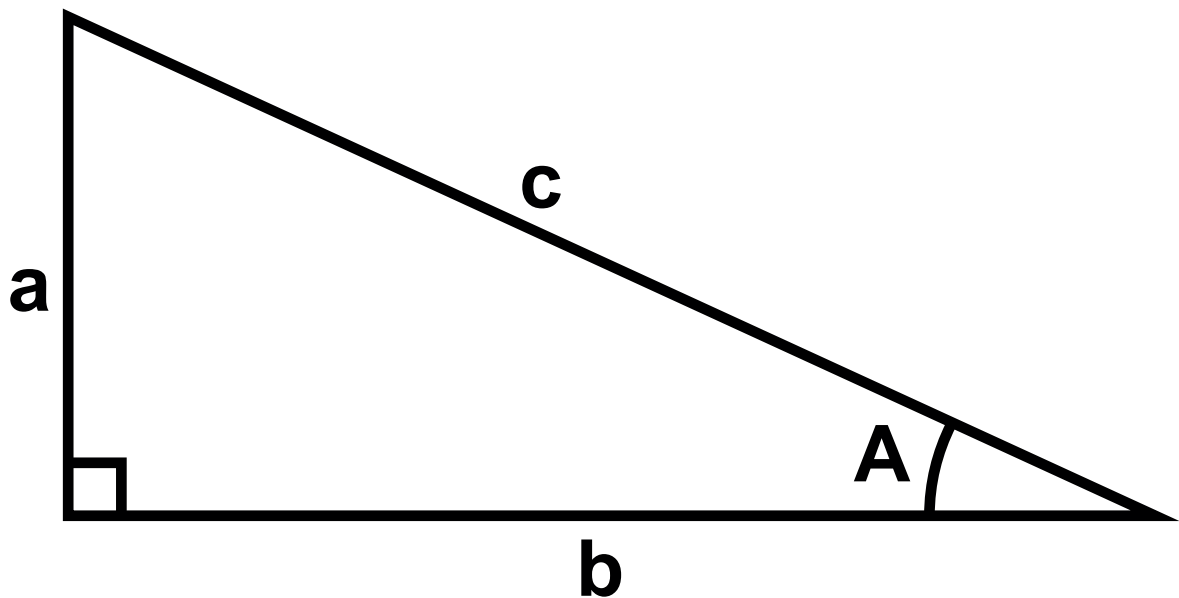
Circumference of a circle =  $2\pi r = \pi d$

Area of a circle =  $\pi r^2$

## Pythagoras' Theorem and Trigonometry

**Pythagoras' Theorem and Trigonometry continued.**

**In any right-angled triangle where  $a$ ,  $b$  and  $c$  are the length of the sides and  $c$  is the hypotenuse:**

$$a^2 + b^2 = c^2$$

**In any right-angled triangle  $ABC$  where  $a$ ,  $b$  and  $c$  are the length of the sides and  $c$  is the hypotenuse:**

$$\sin A = \frac{a}{c} \quad \cos A = \frac{b}{c} \quad \tan A = \frac{a}{b}$$

# Foundation Tier Formulae Sheet

## Compound Interest

Where **P** is the principal amount, **r** is the interest rate over a given period and **n** is number of times that the interest is compounded:

$$\text{Total accrued} = P \left( 1 + \frac{r}{100} \right)^n$$

# Foundation Tier Formulae Sheet

## Probability

Where  $P(A)$  is the probability of outcome **A** and  $P(B)$  is the probability of outcome **B**:

$$P(A \text{ or } B) = P(A) + P(B) - P(A \text{ and } B)$$
