Scale: 1 cm represents 75 metres



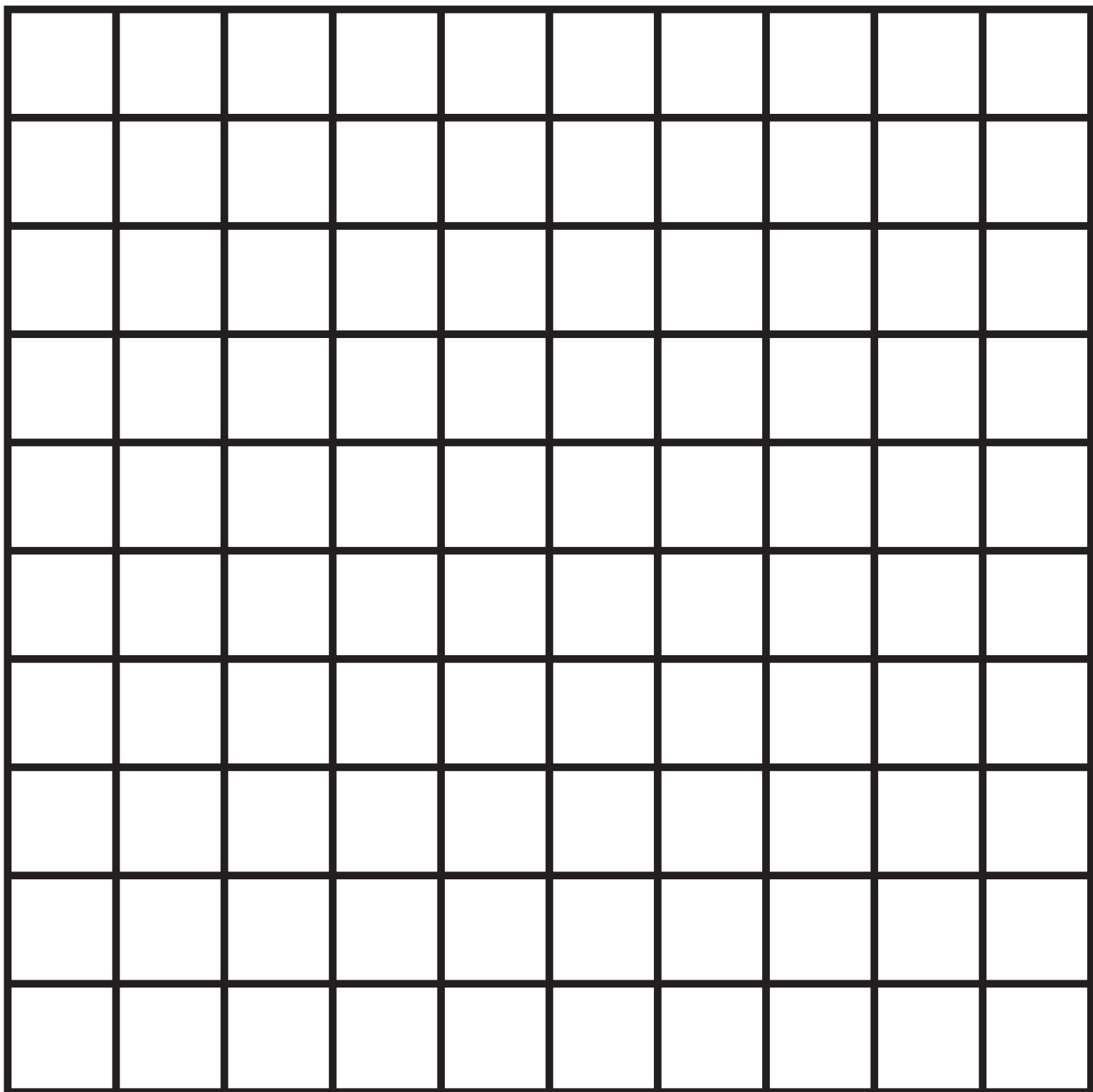
