One square length on the grid represents 1 cm on the solid.

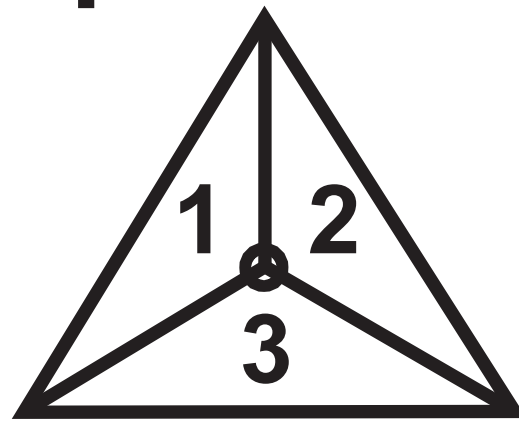

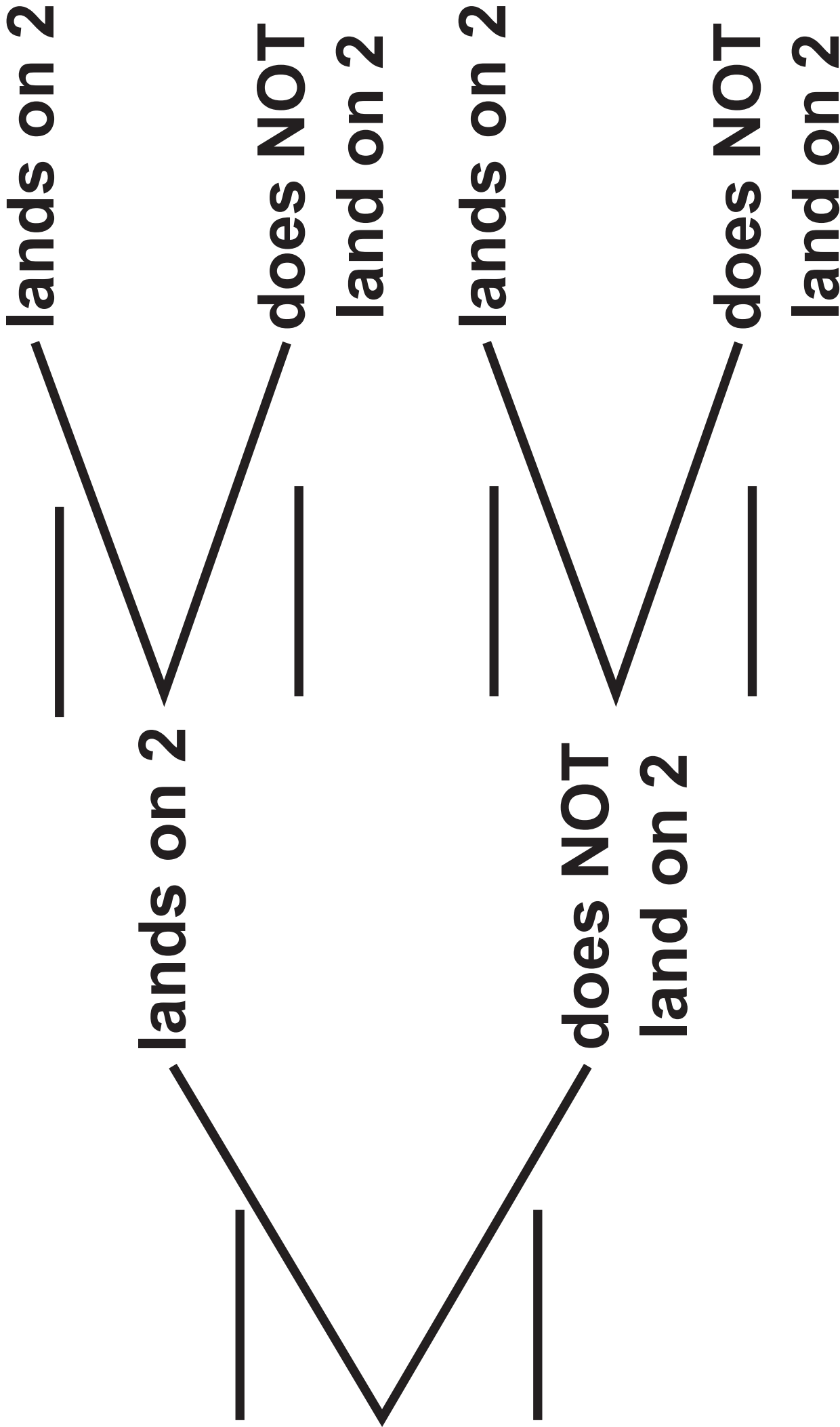
