# Meet your MFL Team



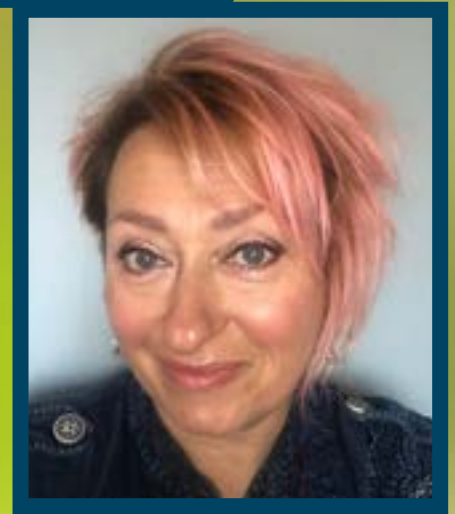
