## Extra Time for GCSE Candidates (1MU0/03)

### Pearson Edexcel Level1/Level 2 GCSE (9-1) Music Component 3: Appraising

Please be advised, for GCSE qualifications, an application for extra time must be submitted using JCQ Access Arrangements Online ([AAO](#)) prior to the candidate's first examination.

Once the approval has been agreed, it is at centre discretion how the extra time is divided dependent on the individual candidate's requirements. The extra time can be allocated at any time throughout the GCSE Music Appraising exam.

However the table below provides an example of how extra time could be applied when divided equally between each question during GCSE Music Appraising exam.

With extra time up to 25% = 26 minutes could be applied as follows:

Start the audio
Play as normal
Immediately after final playing of excerpt for Question 1, pause the audio
Allow extra 1 minute 30 seconds
Start the audio (play the audio as normal, no pauses)
Immediately after final playing of excerpt for Question 2, pause the audio
Allow extra 1 minutes 30 seconds
Repeat process Questions 3-8
At end of examination allow an extra 14 minutes
