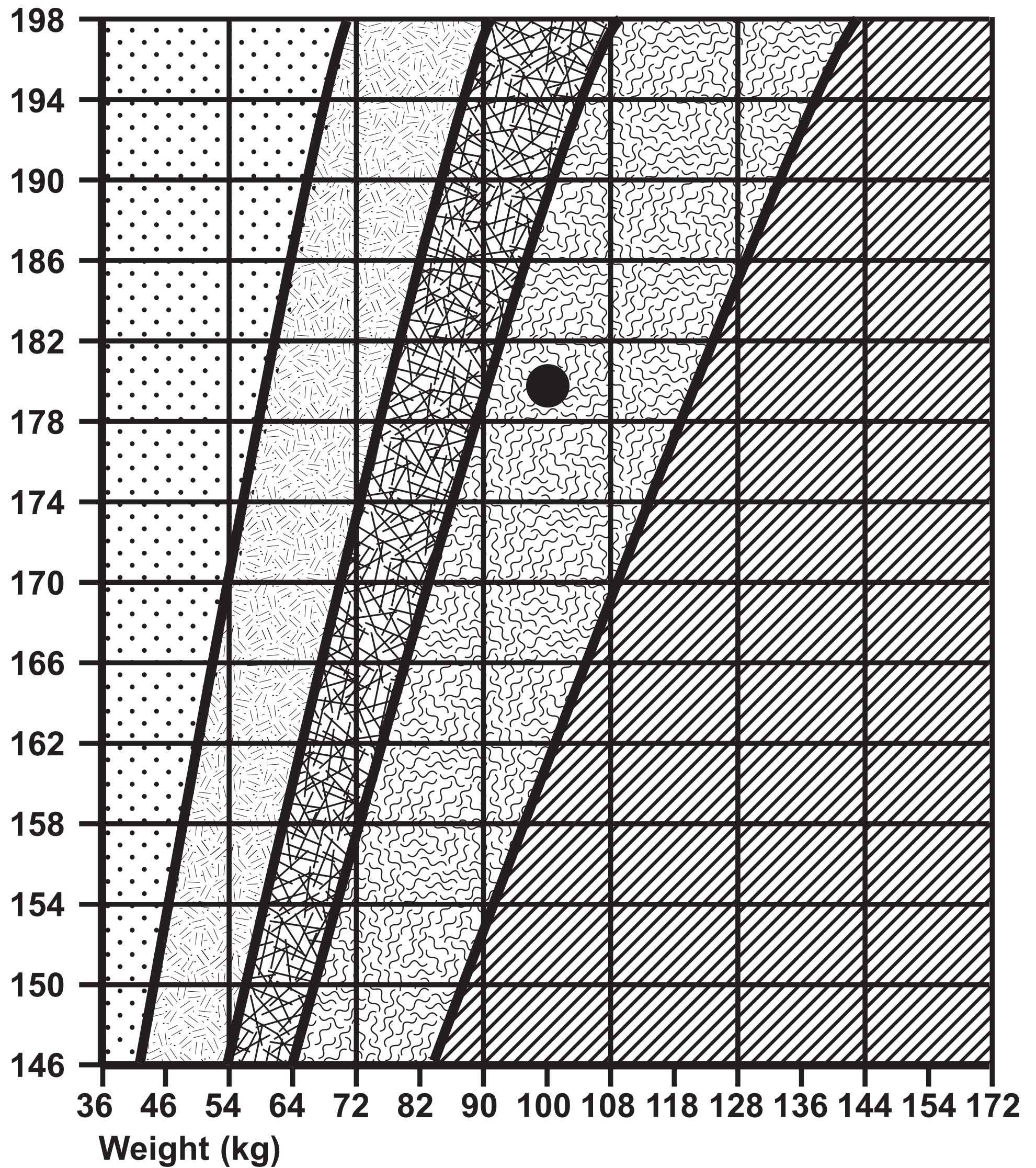

Height (cm)



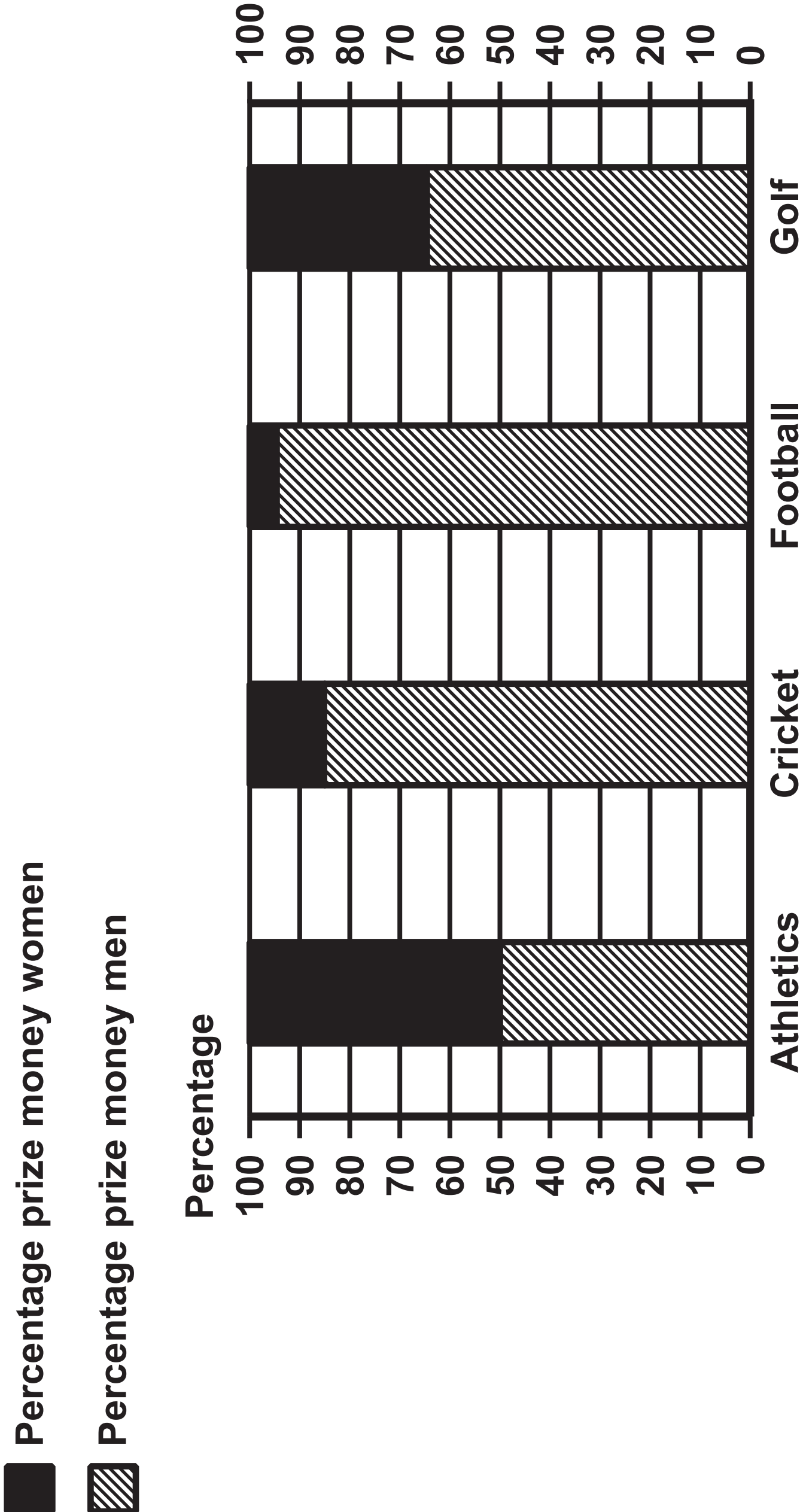

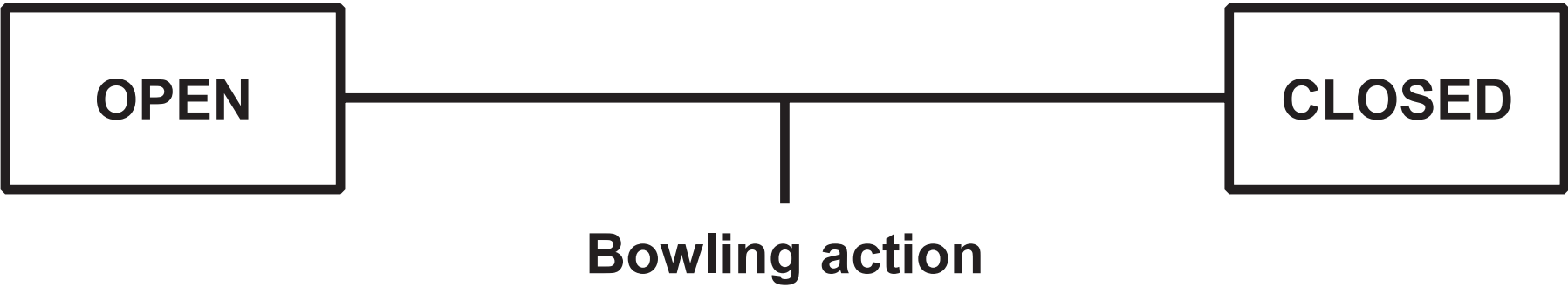

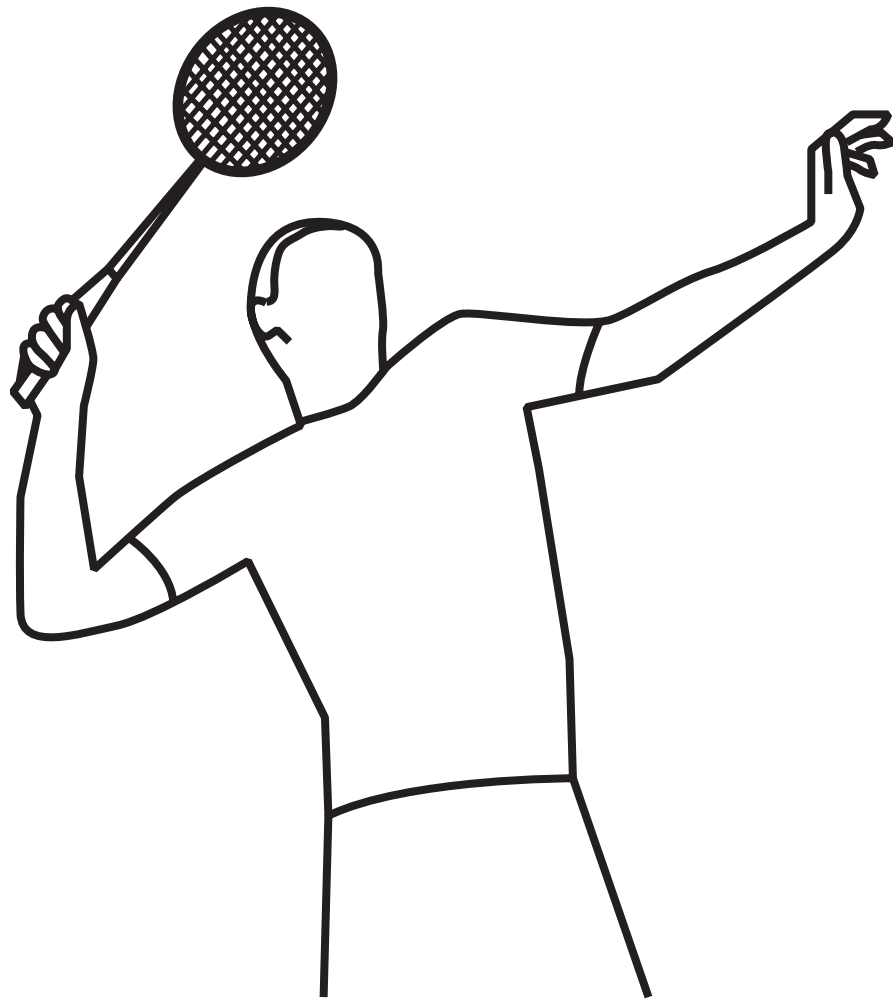

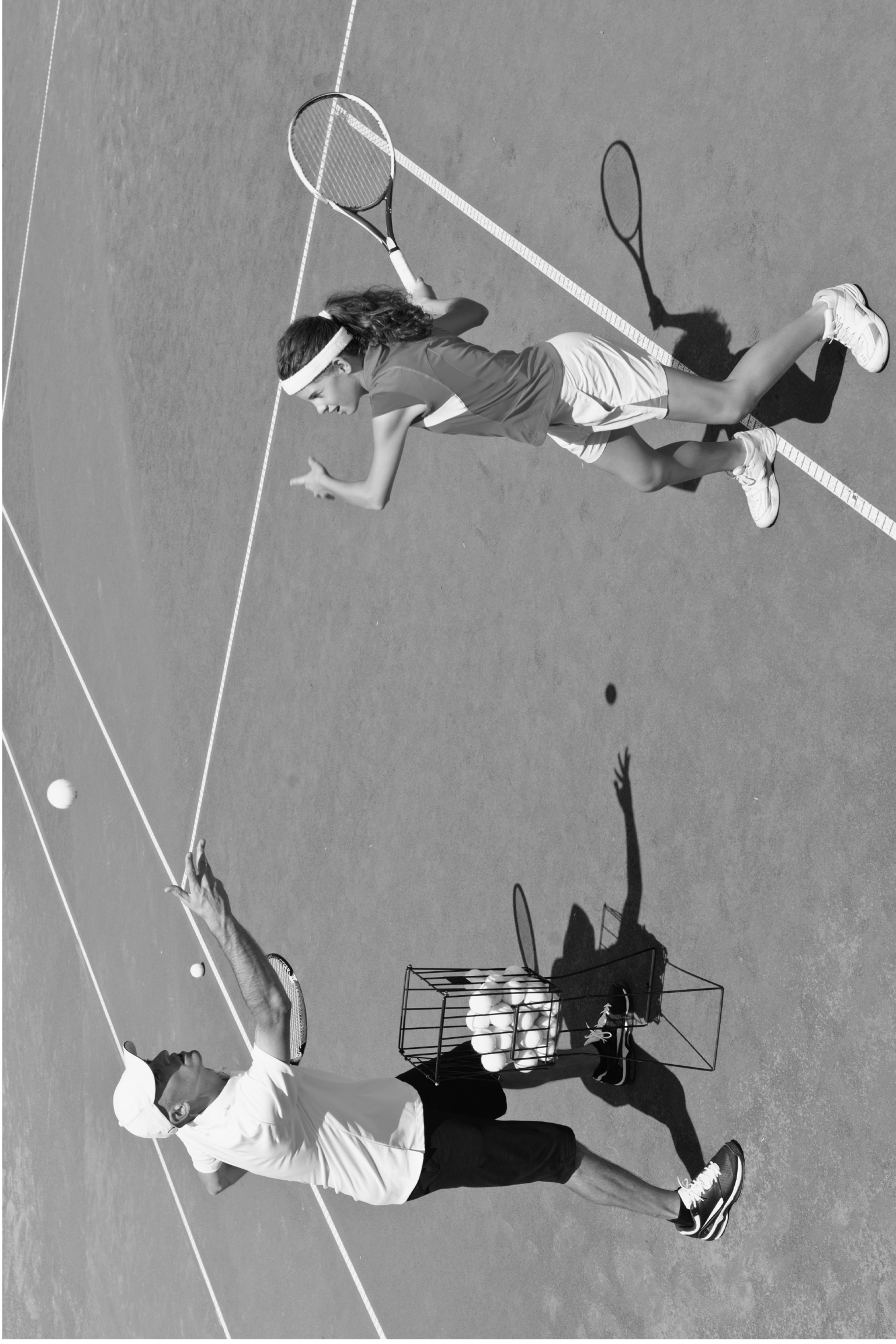
