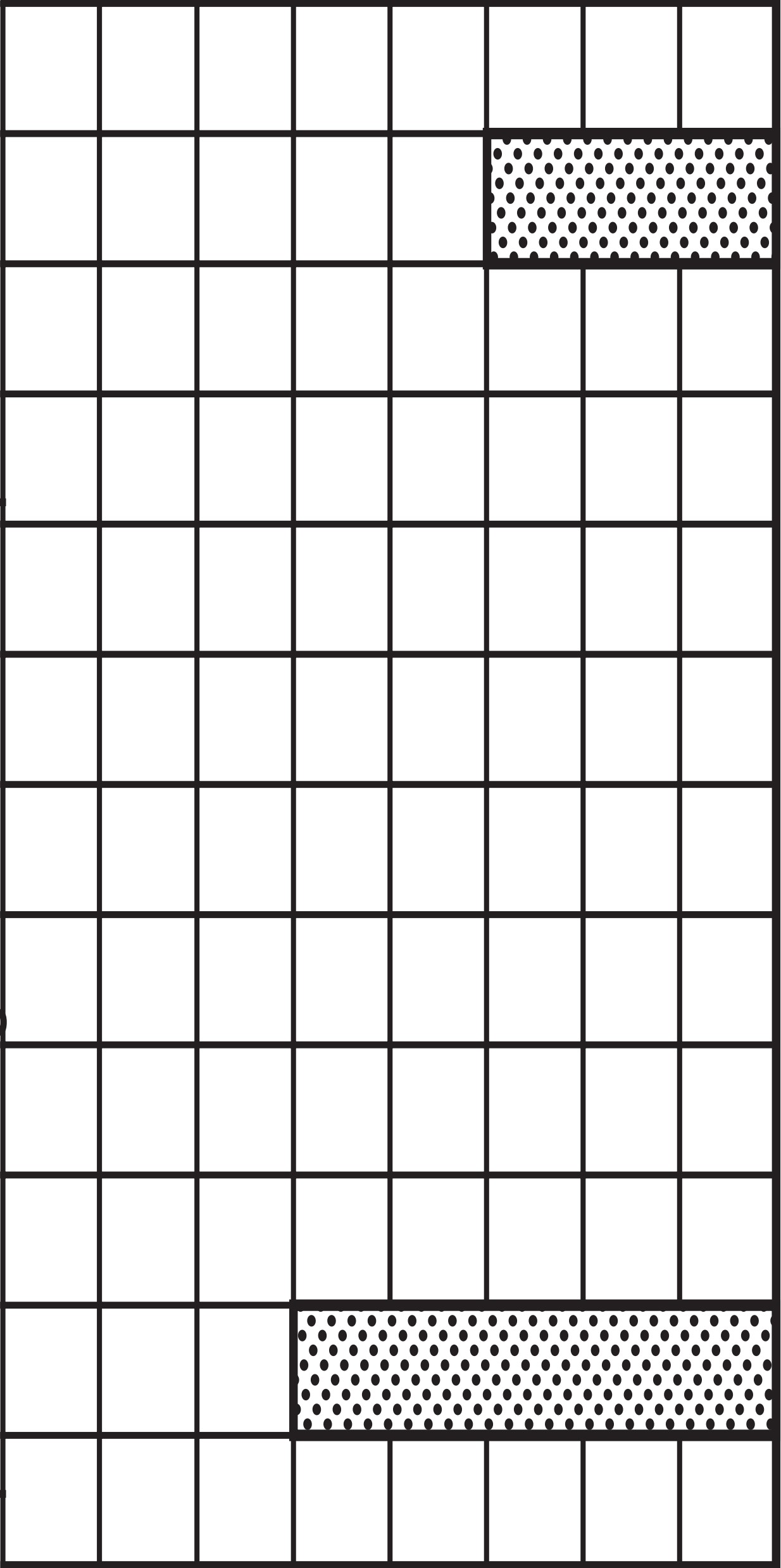

A bar chart to show the number of patients reporting impacts from damage to the left hemisphere of the brain



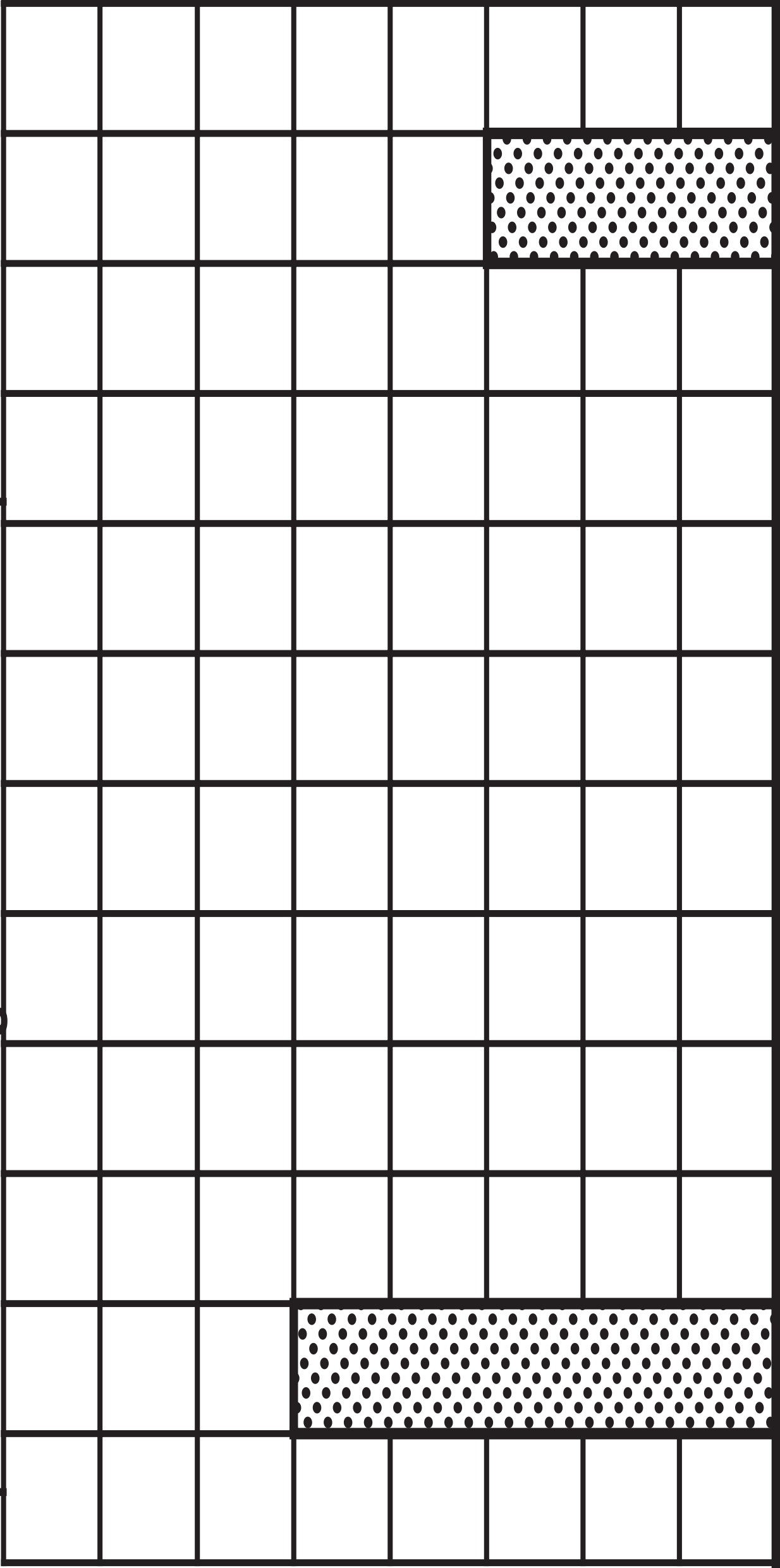

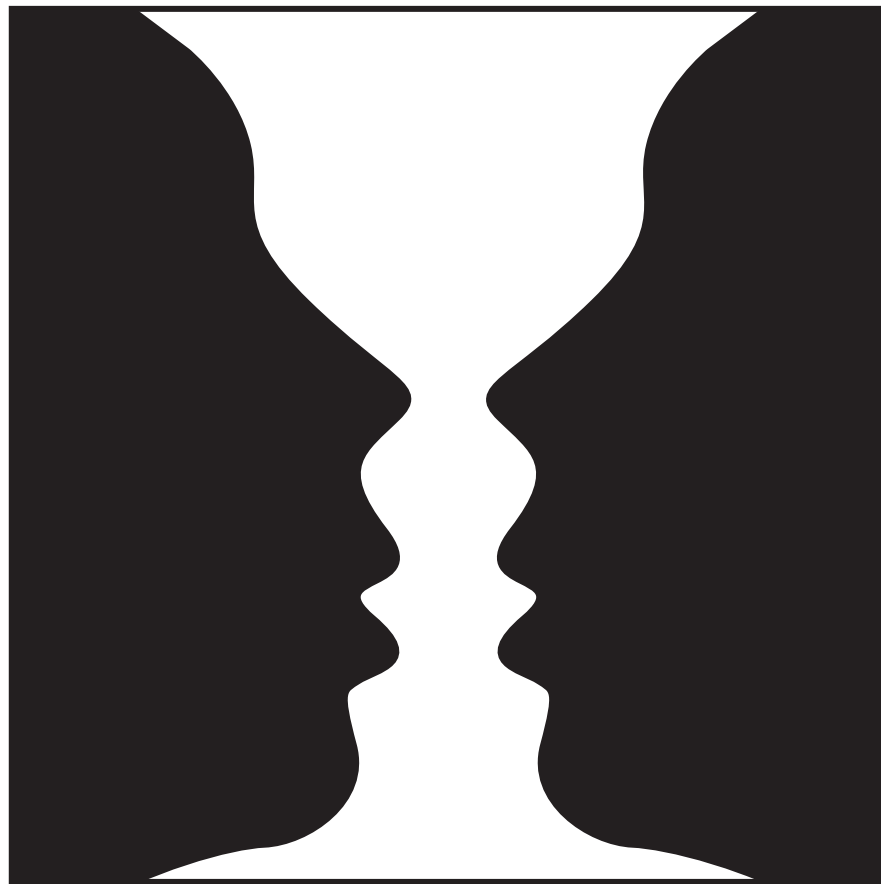

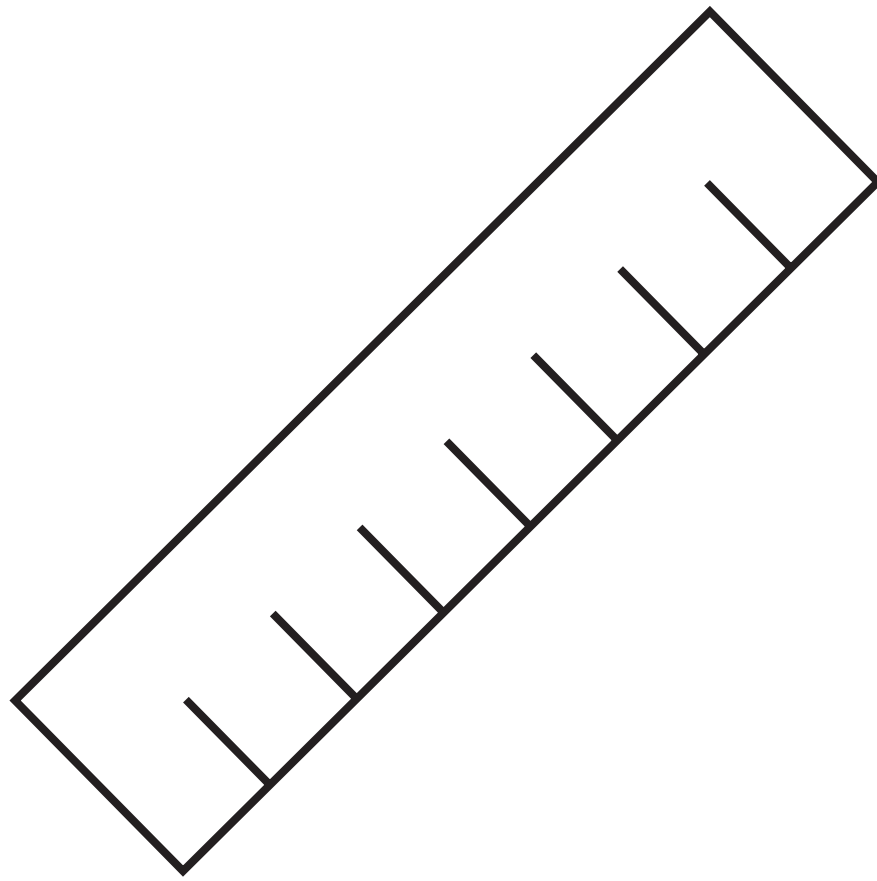
