**Assessment Objective:**

Understand and respond to spoken language (AO1)

**Question 1:****Specification Topic: Free time**

**Feature – with reasons:** Most of the candidates answered this question correctly. The topic was relevant to the candidates.

**Question 2:****Specification Topic: Daily routine**

**Feature – with reasons:** This question nearly has been answered correctly by most of the candidates.

**Question 3:****Specification Topic: Holidays**

**Feature – with reasons:** This year the candidates were more successful in answering this question. However, there are still quite a few candidates tick more than three boxes and lose marks.

Some candidates find it difficult to follow the text and find the names on the table and the correct box. They need more practice using the past papers.

**Question 4:****Specification Topic: Careers**

**Feature – with reasons:** I think the candidates find the text about 'Robots' interesting. Nearly all candidates attempted the question and some scored very good marks. B was the easiest and D was the most challenging question. Those who ticked more than three boxes lost marks.

**Question 5:****Specification Topic: Local Area (holidays)**

**Feature – with reasons:** a) Some candidates misunderstood this question and they gave an answer as 'if the question were' when it was built.'

b) There were many different answers to this question such as 'as a water depot', 'for the palace', 'for the town'.

c) many candidates answered this question correctly.

d) Some candidates understood what is asked and answered the question correctly.

**Question 6:****Specification Topic: Meeting people**

**Feature – with reasons:** This question was answered by most of the candidates correctly.

**Question 7:**

**Specification Topic: A traditional wedding**

**Feature – with reasons:** This question was answered by most of the candidates correctly. Those who did not know the meaning of 'intend' ticked the box A and lost marks.

**Question 8:**

**Specification Topic: School rules**

**Feature – with reasons:** Most of the candidates answered this question correctly. The common mistake was in question (a) 'A car accident happened' and 'Ali wanted to play basketball'.

**Question 9:**

**Specification Topic: A School Trip**

**Feature – with reasons:** This question was answered by most of the candidates. Common mistakes were; (I) mansion, (iv) delicious

**Question 10:**

**Specification Topic: Journey**

**Feature – with reasons:** I think this question was a bit challenging for the candidates. Some answered all questions correctly. However, many candidates found it hard to answer question (c) which was a discriminator. Question (d) was a recall question and answered nearly by all candidates.

**Question 11**

**Specification Topic: Weather**

**Feature – with reasons:**

This question was answered correctly by the candidates who read the rubric carefully. They managed to choose three correct answers. Some who ticked more than three boxes unfortunately lost marks.

Candidates are advised to read the rubric carefully and use the example to understand what is required to get full marks.

**Question 12:**

**Specification Topic: Kaz Mountains**

**Feature – with reasons:** This question was answered by some of the candidates correctly. Common mistakes were; (a) instead of 'strong winds' the mountain was

'high'. (c) the year was written wrong. (d) was answered correctly by most of the candidates.

## **Section B**

### **Question 13:**

**Specification Topic:** Gönüllü kuruluşlar

**Feature – with reasons:** The number of the candidates who scored high marks were not very high this year.

Some candidates found it hard to understand the vocabulary such as anlamak, sanat.

### **Question 14:**

**Specification Topic:** Sosyal Yaşam

**Feature – with reasons:** This question was answered correctly by many candidates. Some candidates got confused when differentiate 'kültürel etkinlikler' and 'gezi'.
