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Assessment Objective: Understand and respond to spoken language (AO1)

Question 1:

Specification Topic: Activities

Most of the candidates answered this question correctly. The topic and the vocabulary used was quite relevant to the candidates.

Question 2:

Specification Topic: Friends

This question has been answered correctly by most of the candidates.

Question 3:

Specification Topic: School Subjects

This question was answered by most of the candidates.

Question 4

Specification Topic: Traditional music

This question was answered correctly by the candidates who read the rubric carefully. They managed to choose three correct answers. Very few who ticked more than three boxes unfortunately lost marks.

Candidates are advised to read the rubric carefully and use the example to understand what is required to get full marks.

Question 5:

Specification topic: Role Models

Most of the candidates were awarded full marks for this question. However, the common mistakes were (ii) thinking critically.

Question 6:

Specification topic: daily life

Most of the candidates answered this question correctly. The topic was interesting for the candidates.

- (a) This question was answered by most of the candidates
- (b) Some candidates managed to explain because there was not much to do in the village, and some explained it saying, "The town was small." The common mistake was "The house was small."
- (c) This question was challenging for some candidates. They did not notice the word "favourite" in the question and wrote other activities they do and lost marks. The candidates are advised to read the rubric very carefully and understand what is required.
- (d) The first part of the question was answered correctly by many candidates. The second part of the question was answered by some candidates

correctly. They managed to write what the reason was for them to go to the cinema. The common mistake was, "The actors / the film was funny."

Question 7

Specification Topic: Eurovision song contest

- (a) Some of the candidates gave "İzmir" as an answer and lost marks.
- (b) The candidates answered this question in different ways such as 'It was too hot to go to the beach', and "The beach was too far to go on a hot day. They were awarded full marks.
- (c) Nearly most candidates answered this question correctly. Some candidates explained that the family liked the pasta she cooked by saying they had a lot.
- (d) Some candidates gave, "The family send the children to the bakery" and lost marks.
- (e) Most of the candidates answered this recall question correctly.

Question 8:

Specification Topic: Shopping

This question was answered correctly by most of the candidates.

Part (a) (i) This question was generally answered correctly by many candidates. The common mistake was "fresh."

- (ii) The common mistake was "trolleys."
- (iii) The common mistake was "old designs"

Part (b) (i) This question was generally answered correctly by many candidates. The common mistakes were "fresher/ cheaper."

- (ii) (iii) These questions were answered correctly by many candidates.

Question 9:

- (I) Many candidates answered this question correctly.
- (II) Some candidates gave "healthy soul" as one of the answers and they got one mark for that.
- (III) Most of the candidates managed to answer this question correctly.
- (IV) Some candidates answered this question correctly.
- (V) Most of the candidates managed to answer this question correctly.

Part (b)

- (i) I think the candidates found this question challenging. Those who managed to get a mark gave very different answers such as, "We should not think about using them, we should not be friends for our benefits."
- (ii) These questions were answered correctly by many candidates.

Question 10:

Specification Topic: Tiles of Kütahya

The topic was relevant to most of the candidates. Most candidates answered this question correctly.
