

Edexcel GCSE (9–1) Design and Technology 2017 free Student Book offer

Terms and conditions

Q: What is included in the free Student Books offer?

A: The offer is a free class set of 30 Edexcel GCSE (9–1) Design and Technology Student Books from Pearson worth £630, which will be given to all UK centres that choose to teach the Edexcel GCSE (9–1) Design and Technology specification in 2017 and enter students for the 2019 assessments. To sign up for this offer you will need to complete the Intention to Offer (ITO) form, providing us with the full details requested. This offer closes on Tuesday 31 July 2018.

Q: What if I don't enter 30 students for the 2019 assessments?

A: We do appreciate that the final decision on entries for the new GCSEs won't be made until spring 2019. If your centre has signed up to teach the new Edexcel GCSE in Design and Technology in 2017 but does not then make any entries with us for GCSE in 2019, we will simply invoice you in 2019 for the class set of 30 Student Books. If you enter fewer than 30 students for the 2019 assessment you will not be invoiced for the class set.

Q: What if I'm not a current Edexcel centre – can I still sign up for the free Student Books?

A: Any UK centre can sign up to teach our new Edexcel GCSE (9–1) Design and Technology qualification and they will then receive the free Student Books, however, if that centre does not then make any entries with us for GCSE in 2019, we will simply invoice you in 2019 for the class set of 30 Student Books. If you enter fewer than 30 students for the 2019 assessment you will not be invoiced for the class set. Please note, this offer of free student books is only available to UK establishments. It is not available to centres outside the UK.

Q: Is this an ongoing offer or a one-off?

A: This is a one-off to help you start teaching the new qualification. The offer closes on Tuesday 31 July 2018.

Q: How does this offer work?

A: Once your centre has decided which exam board to teach in 2017 and has completed an ITO form you will automatically be sent the books upon publication.

Q: What if I'm registering more than 30 students for the qualification?

A: If you require more than the 30 Student Books provided in this offer please contact our Customer Service Team at customersolutions@pearson.com stating the number of additional Student Books you require. You may request up to a maximum of 10 additional Student Books.

Q: When will I receive my Student Books?

A: You will receive your 30 Student Books upon publication in June 2017. To ensure that you receive the books in a timely fashion please include on the ITO form the name of your Head of Department (if not completing the form) and full details of where the books should be dispatched.

Q: What if I change my mind?

A: If you change your mind and no longer intend to teach our Edexcel GCSE (9–1) Design and Technology qualification you must let us know before 30th April 2017 by sending an email to TeachingDesignandTechnology@pearson.com.

Q: Will students need this Student Book to pass the exam?

A: The Student Book is not required to achieve this Pearson qualification, nor is it the only suitable material available to support the qualification, and any resource lists produced by the awarding body shall include the Pearson Student Book and other appropriate resources.
