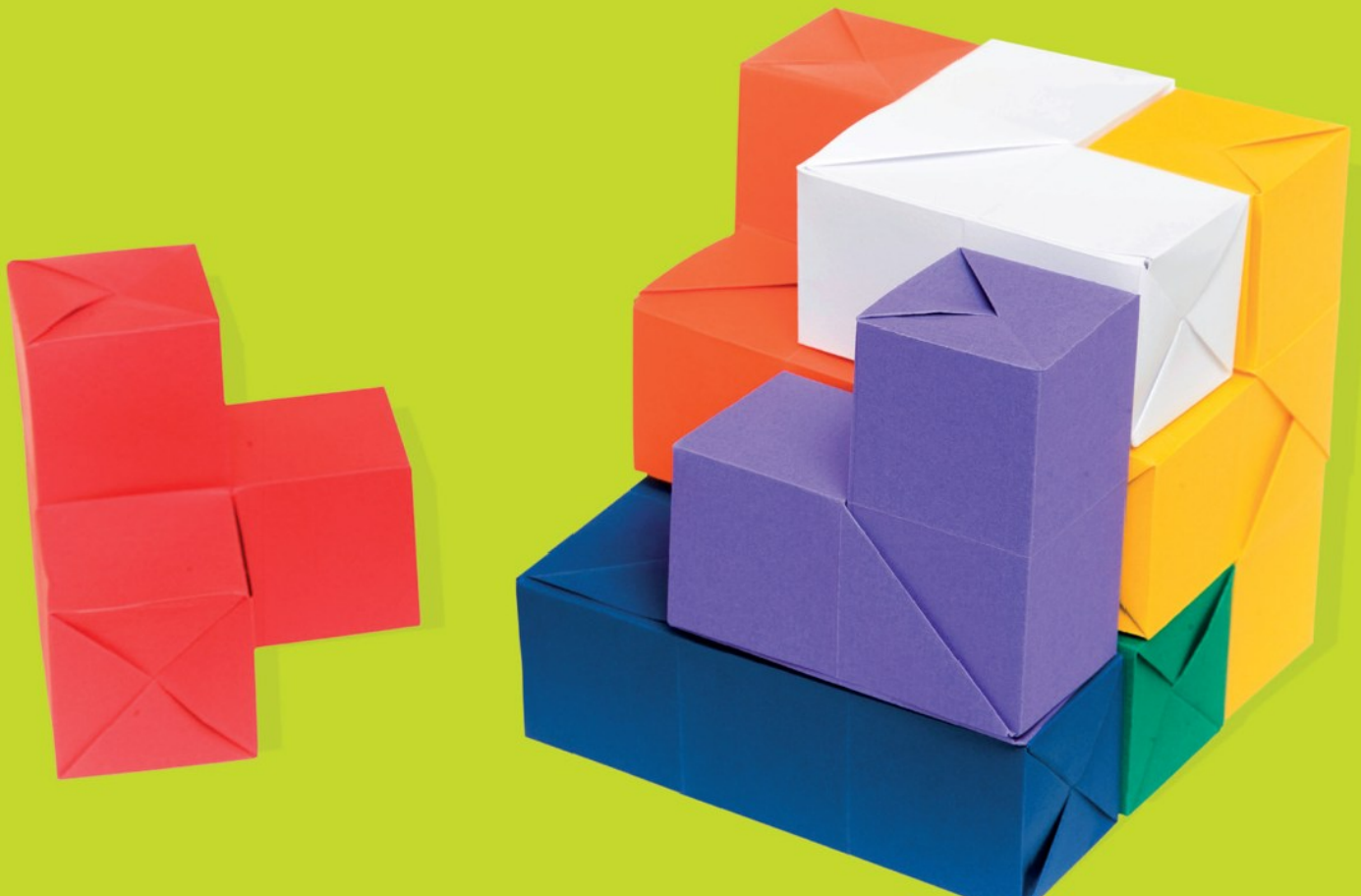

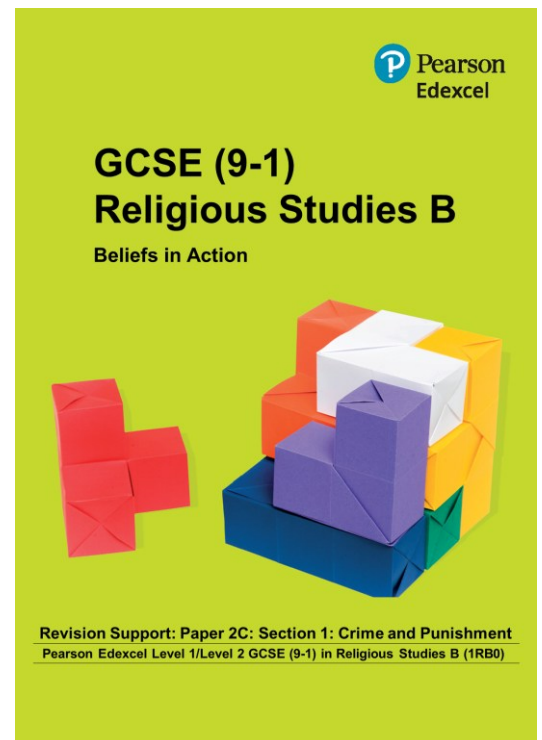

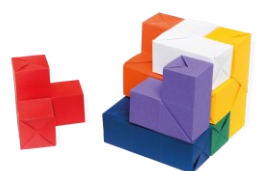
How to use this resource
