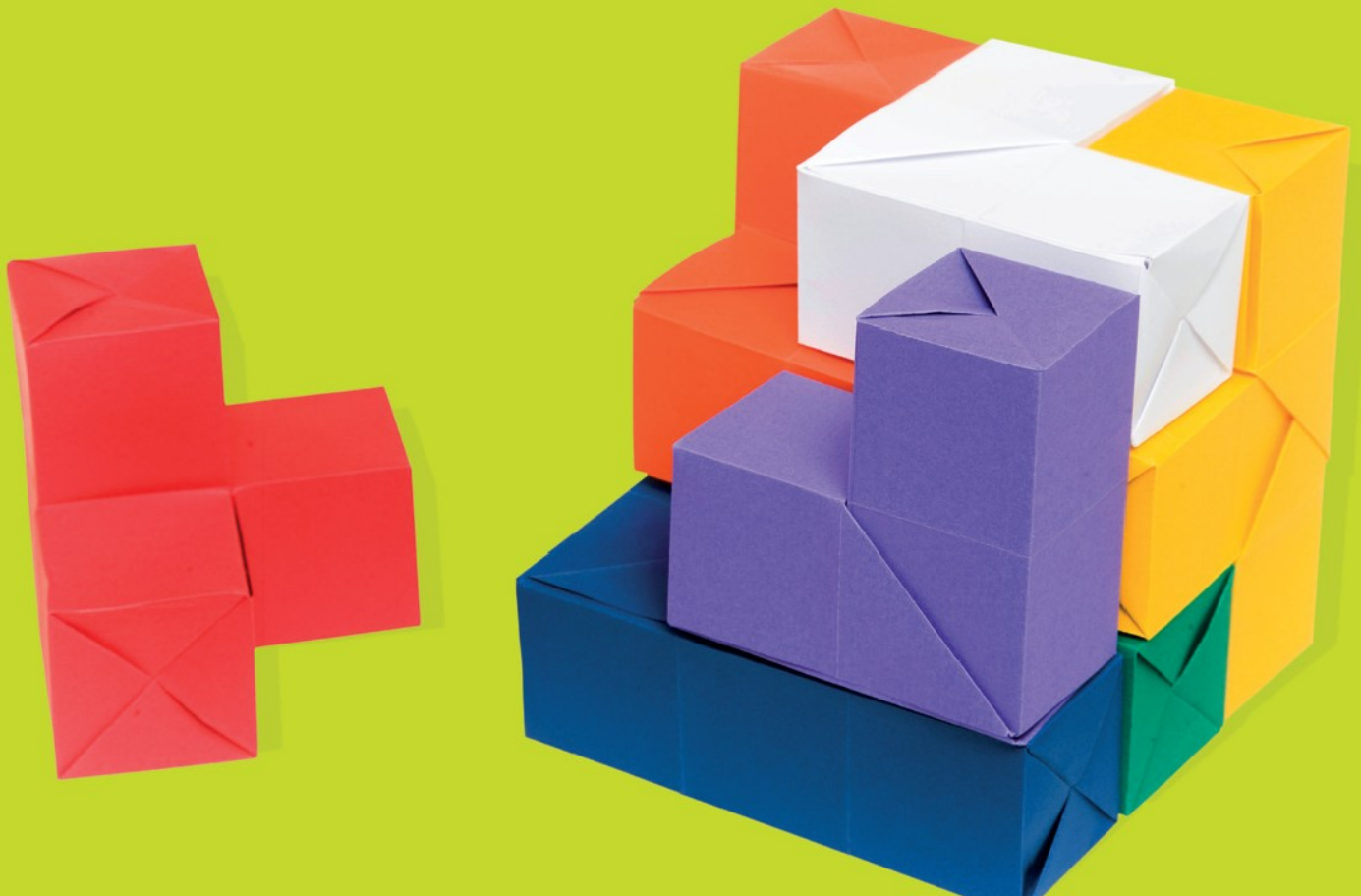

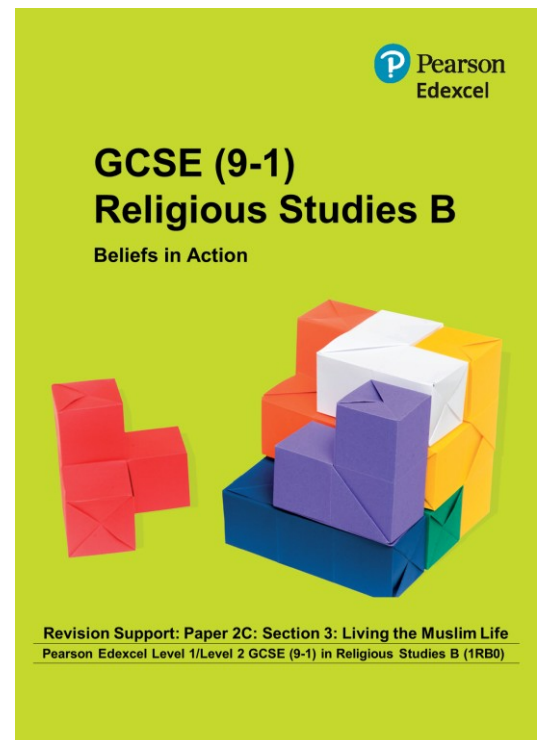

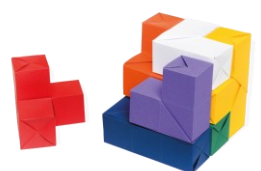
#### How to use this resource
