The candidate was awarded **34** marks.

- The candidate's development of ideas and investigations evidences fully emerging competent ability in the critical understanding of their own ideas and the sources that have informed them.
- When refining work, the selection and use of media shows a willingness to experiment with a variety of techniques and processes. This demonstrates mostly emerging competent ability.
- The candidate's observations, skills and experiences when recording ideas relevant to intentions are at fully emerging competent ability level.
- The final outcome demonstrates mostly emerging competent ability to produce a personal and meaningful response.
- To gain full marks in performance band three, the candidate would need to be much more broadening in approach.
