Activity 1 – Elements of Assessment

Purpose:

- Understanding the fundamental instruments of assessment process
 - Learn about the various elements of assessment
-

Task

- a. There will be a brainstorming session. Delegates will be asked to write different instruments of assessment.
- b. Then there will be a discussion session for 5 minutes and delegates will be given the answer.

Activity 2 – Answering MCQ

Purpose:

- Learning how text for multiple choice questions are written and how distracters are selected

Task

- a. There will be group discussion about the technique of writing text and setting questions for MCQ.
- b. Delegates will answer the questions and discuss how the correct answer is selected.

Activity 3 – Answering questions from Reading Test

Purpose:

Learning how to match answers against simple statements in the text

Task

- a. Delegates will read three statements by three people on holiday
- b. They will put crosses across the statements under the person who made that statement

Activity 4: Answering questions from a text for question on short answer

Purpose:

How to elicit short answers from a lengthy text

Task:

- a. Delegates will read the text carefully
- b. Delegates will give five short answers by extracting information from the text
