

Pearson Edexcel Level 1/Level 2 International GCSE (9-1) in English Literature (4ET1) May/June 2021 assessment arrangements

Ofqual announced on 3 August 2020 changes to the 2021 May/June examination series for UK Qualifications. The changes are an interim measure to address any impact COVID-19 has had/will have on students taking their examination in 2021.

Although the changes announced do not have an impact on this qualification, we have decided to make the changes listed below to ensure that the International Qualifications remain comparable to their UK counterparts. The information below details the changes have been made to our specification for students taking their final examinations in May/June 2021.

The changes outlined in this document are correct as of 4/09/2020.

Summary of the current assessment/content arrangements

International GCSE English Literature

Paper 1: Poetry and Modern Prose
