

Using the passive



Present tense

The cat is chasing the mouse.

Le chat *chasse* la souris.

The mouse is being chased by the cat.

La souris *est chassée* par le chat.

Perfect tense

The cat caught the mouse.

Le chat *a attrapé* la souris.

The mouse was caught by the cat.

La souris *a été attrapée* par le chat.

Future

The cat will eat the mouse.

Le chat *mangera* la souris.

The mouse will be eaten by the cat.

La souris *sera mangée* par le chat.
