

# Pearson Edexcel Level 1/Level 2 International GCSE (9-1) in History (4HI1) May/June 2021 assessment arrangements

Ofqual announced on 3 August 2020 changes to the 2021 May/June examination series for UK Qualifications. The changes are an interim measure to address any impact COVID-19 has had/will have on students taking their examination in 2021.

Although the changes announced do not have an impact on this qualification, we have decided to make the changes listed below to ensure that the International Qualification remain comparable to their UK counterparts. The information below details what changes have been made to our specification for students taking their final examinations in May/June 2021.

The changes outlined in this document are correct as of 4/09/2020.

## Summary of the May/June 2021 assessment/content arrangements

For May/June 2021 examination series only, students will study and be assessed on 3 topics instead of 4 as follows:

### Option A - Choose two topics in Paper 1 as usual and in Paper 2 choose one topic in Section A.

**Option B** – Choose **one topic in Paper 1** and in **Paper 2 choose two topics (one from Section A and one from Section B)** as usual.

Section A: Historical Investigation, in Paper 2, is compulsory in both options.

Teachers can therefore choose to drop <u>EITHER</u> one Paper 1 depth study <u>OR</u> the Paper 2 study in breadth.
