- (c) From lines X describe the dangers and difficulties of the swim. You may support your points with brief quotations. **(5)**

In your answer you should write about:

- the writer's description of the accident
- Aron Ralston's thoughts
- the writer's use of language

Support your answer with examples from the extract.
