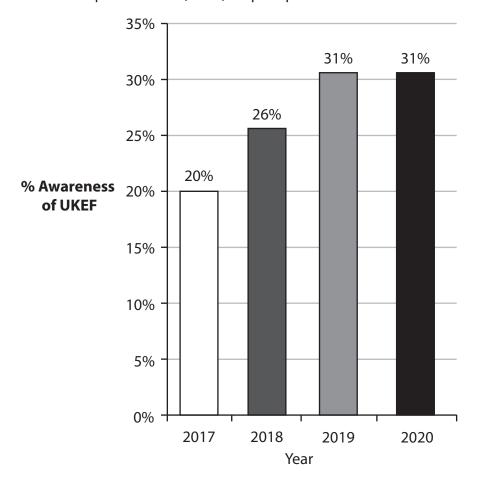

The global market for electric cars and their batteries is growing. However, there is a shortage of some of the minerals needed to produce the batteries.

Technology Minerals PLC (TMP) found a solution to this problem. It developed a new technology to recycle electric car batteries. It had to raise enough capital to open five factories in the UK. Banks are often unwilling to risk lending to businesses developing new technologies.

In November 2021, *TMP* listed for the first time on the London Stock Exchange. Investors were able to buy shares at the beginning of the first day for an initial price of £2.25. This raised £1.5 million for *TMP*, which was enough to open the five factories. By the end of the first day the share price had increased to £3.25.
