HOUSE REMOVAL

Thank you for your email through our website enquiring about a quotation for a house removal from your home in Coventry to your new home in Epsom, Surrey.

SOME REMOVAL TIPS

Our promise to you – we will do everything possible to make sure that your forthcoming house move is as stress-free as possible.

1 PREPARE

Decide well in advance on the items you will be taking with you. Sell or donate to charity those items no longer required. (We can give you details of charities that will collect unwanted furniture.)

2 NON-RETURNABLE BOXES

We have thousands of them! All are flat packed so store easily. When we have confirmed your removal date, let us know how many boxes you require and we will deliver on the next working day. Start packing as soon as possible. It helps us if you label each box with the room it is intended for in your new property. It helps you if you note on the box what is inside.

3 PARKING

Ensure that on removal day we can park our lorry outside your house. If you have a large, vacant driveway, so much the better.

4 PETS

Keep them out of everyone's way on removal day – in the bathroom is best because we rarely have to remove furniture from a bathroom. We can provide pet carriers for cats and small animals such as hamsters.

Remember to arrange for your final gas, electricity and water meter readings. Have you considered redirection of your mail? Have you told your bank?
