

## Pearson LCCI Level 2 Certificate in Cost Accounting - Command verbs

### Taxonomies

Each subject should have an agreed taxonomy defined together with the expectations of candidates when answering these command words. Writers should adhere to this agreed taxonomy throughout.

<b>Give</b> <b>State</b> <b>Identify</b> <b>Describe</b>	Assessing factual information. Use of a single word but sometimes a few words are required to a maximum of a single sentence.
<b>Explain</b> <b>Compare</b>	More detail and/or understanding in responses. Learners use linkage words such as 'therefore', 'so that' and 'because'.
<b>Prepare</b> <b>Complete</b>	Number of stages to complete in the preparation of (financial) statements, accurately inputting figures or information into a specific format, e.g. a table.
<b>Calculate</b>	Work out a numerical problem, showing how they arrived at their answer. Use appropriate processes in their response.
<b>Analyse</b> <b>Advise</b> <b>Evaluate</b>	Interpret cost data and information and recognise patterns and correlations, in order to build a reasoned decision and draw conclusions.
