Overview

This written assessment is a two-hour closed-book examination. You will be permitted to use a nonprogrammable, non-printing calculator during the examination. The assessment center will provide any necessary pencils. No extra papers, books, notes or study materials are allowed in the testing area.

Assessment Development

NCCER will send appropriate credentials (certificate, wallet card and official transcript) to the assessment center upon successful completion of the written assessment.

National Registry

The Level Two Application Specialist performs the full range of surface preparation and coating applications in a safe manner according to industry regulations and supervises Level One Specialists in these duties.
