Objective

The candidate will demonstrate the ability to clean with power tools, spray paint, brush and roll paint, and use proper rigging techniques. The candidate must complete these key tasks within time specified by evaluator.

Scope

This Performance Verification provides a means to observe and evaluate competencies in the following areas:

- Power tool cleaning
- Spray painting
- Brush and roller painting
- Rigging
- Sand blasting
- Water blasting

Materials Required

- Paint and mixing specifications
- Brush–Roller–Pan
- Spray Gun
- Cleaning tools
- Drop cloths
- Compressor/Pot/Hoses, etc.
- Cleaning supplies (MSDS for chemicals / solvents)
- Rigging equipment
- Personal Protective Equipment

Time Required

To be determined based on job site conditions.

Tasks

- **Power Tool Cleaning**
 - Connect and run air hoses
 - Connect oiler whips
 - Connect power tool (sander/needle gun)
 - Clean area to be painted
 - Clean-up work area

Tasks (cont'd)

- **Spray Painting**
 - Set up
 - Tear down and rebuild gun
 - Put gun in spray line
 - Verify wind direction
 - Mix paint to specifications
 - Connect air supply to pot
 - Check spray pattern
 - Apply spray paint (600 square feet)
 - Clean up (equipment and work area)

- **Brush and roll painting**
 - Place drop cloths
 - Mix paint to specifications
 - Apply paint (600 square foot)
 - Clean up (equipment and work area)

- **Rigging**

(You will be given specific tasks by your evaluator)

 - Safety harness
 - Life lines
 - Clamps-on-cable
 - Cable protector
