Pearson Edexcel Level 6 NVQ Diploma in Senior Site Inspection (Construction)

What is the purpose of this qualification?

This qualification is for Construction Managers, with particular responsibilities for inspecting, monitoring and managing projects on site. It is designed to assess and prove occupational competence in the workplace to a recognised standard in the construction industry

What does this qualification cover?

This qualification is based on the National Occupational Standards for Senior Site Inspection and is vocationally-related in its content. As an NVQ, all units within the qualifications are derived from these occupational standards directly, and evidence of knowledge, skill and understanding will be gained from a workplace or a realistic workplace situation.

It covers the following topics:

- Monitoring Project Quality
- Managing Project Progress and Handover
- Verifying and Maintaining systems for Site Health, Safety and Welfare Management
- Setting up and Managing Technical Information systems
- Managing Interaction with others and professional practice

Optional topics include:

- Monitoring test processes,
- confirming and reporting on property condition
- Implementing policies & programmes for maintenance works

- Monitoring and solving customer service problems
- Evaluating and progressing dispute resolution
- Recruiting and planning the workforce
- Managing and developing teams and individuals

Who can take this qualification?

This qualification is for all learners aged 18 and above who are capable of reaching the required standards and have opportunity to demonstrate practical skills in a realistic construction working environment. Learners do not need any prior qualifications, knowledge or experience before starting the qualification. They are likely, however to be working as Site Managers and/or Site Inspectors already, or have opportunity to take on responsibilities at that level. This qualification is not a component of an apprenticeship

What can this qualification lead to?

Learners may use the qualification to gain employment as Site Managers, as a Clerk of Works on a construction site, or Site Inspectors with responsibility for quality control and monitoring projects on site, to ensure compliance with safety and quality requirements.

The qualification may be used as evidence to prove competence to prospective employers, directly or as a component of card competence schemes. Such schemes are not a licence to practice and can be achieved by different routes (e.g. through the experienced worker route), but are widely recognised and used by many employers as proof of competence and access to sites.

How is this qualification assessed?

A portfolio of evidence gathered from a range of sources including workplace activities and realistic work environments, professional discussions, questioning and observation of performance
