Spiders and Flies: An Eritrean Story

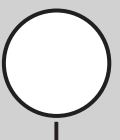
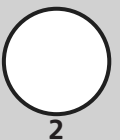


Once there was a prince who hated spiders and flies. “There’s no point in them!” he moaned to his mother, the queen. “They are ugly, and they do no work!”

The journey was long and hard, and the prince's enemies followed close behind him. He ran and ran until he was exhausted, and then he fell asleep under a tree.



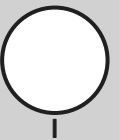
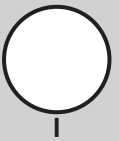

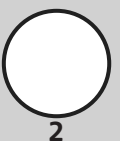
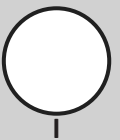
After a while, the prince heard his enemies approaching.
