What is the purpose of this qualification?

The Entry 2 Certificate is part of a suite of qualifications in Personal and Social Development available from entry to level 2. The Certificate is an appropriate size for learners who may need to gain in confidence and cover a range of skill areas. The qualification is designed to meet the personal and social needs of learners. The range of units available reflect the personalised and flexible approach of this qualification, unit choices can be matched to individual skill development needs such as confidence building, working with others or preparation for work.

How does this qualification differ from other Entry 2 Personal and Social development qualifications?

The Entry Level Certificate in Personal and Social Development has a primary focus on independence and life skills. Pearson offers another suite of entry 2 qualifications in skills for Independence and Work. These qualifications offer students the opportunity to develop skills that will enable them to transition from personal development to vocational learning. This is provided by the choice of vocational units that have been designed to provide students with the experience of vocational learning within a simulated or home environment.

What does this qualification cover?

All the content of the qualification, relates directly to the skills, knowledge and understanding needed to support students in progressing to further study. This qualification is 13 credits in size taken from a choice of 22 optional units at entry level and a further choice of 19 units at a higher level, this is because the qualification recognises that students may be better at or not so good in certain skills areas. Therefore the qualification allows students to choose units from higher levels in order to stretch their learning.

The units cover topics such as; goal setting, dealing with everyday problems, working as part of a group, developing self, managing social relationships, individual rights and responsibilities, community action, healthy living, preparation for work and money management.

The Certificate in Personal and Social Development is usually studied alongside other qualifications and activities, such as English, Mathematics and vocational learning as part of a broader learning programme.

Is this qualification available in an apprenticeship?

This is an entry level qualification and is not available as part of an apprenticeship.

Who could take this qualification?

This qualification is aimed at any learners over the age of 14 who wish to improve their personal and social skills in order to be able to manage their relationships, develop confidence and prepare for employment.

What are the qualification outcomes?

The primary outcome of this qualification is to support individuals to operate effectively in life, learning and work, by developing the skills necessary to succeed in further study and employment. In addition the qualification will suit learners who are returning or re-engaging with learning and need to consolidate their learning, social and employability skills before considering entering work. The choice of units will reflect each individual learner's needs.

What higher level learning will this qualification lead to?

Personal and Social Development qualifications are designed to support broader learning programmes. Their intention is to support the development of skills within a vocational context. Therefore students may progress to any higher level qualification.

Why choose the Certificate in Personal and Social Development?

The Pearson Edexcel Entry Level Certificate in Personal and Social Development will suit students working at this level who are looking to address a small number of identified skills gaps in order to overcome barriers to work or to support them in re-engaging with learning. By studying the Award, students will develop the identified skills in preparation for higher level vocational learning.

Pearson offers the Entry Level 2 Award in Personal and Social Development for those students wishing to study and develop a narrower range of skills. Other similar qualifications are also available at higher and lower levels.
