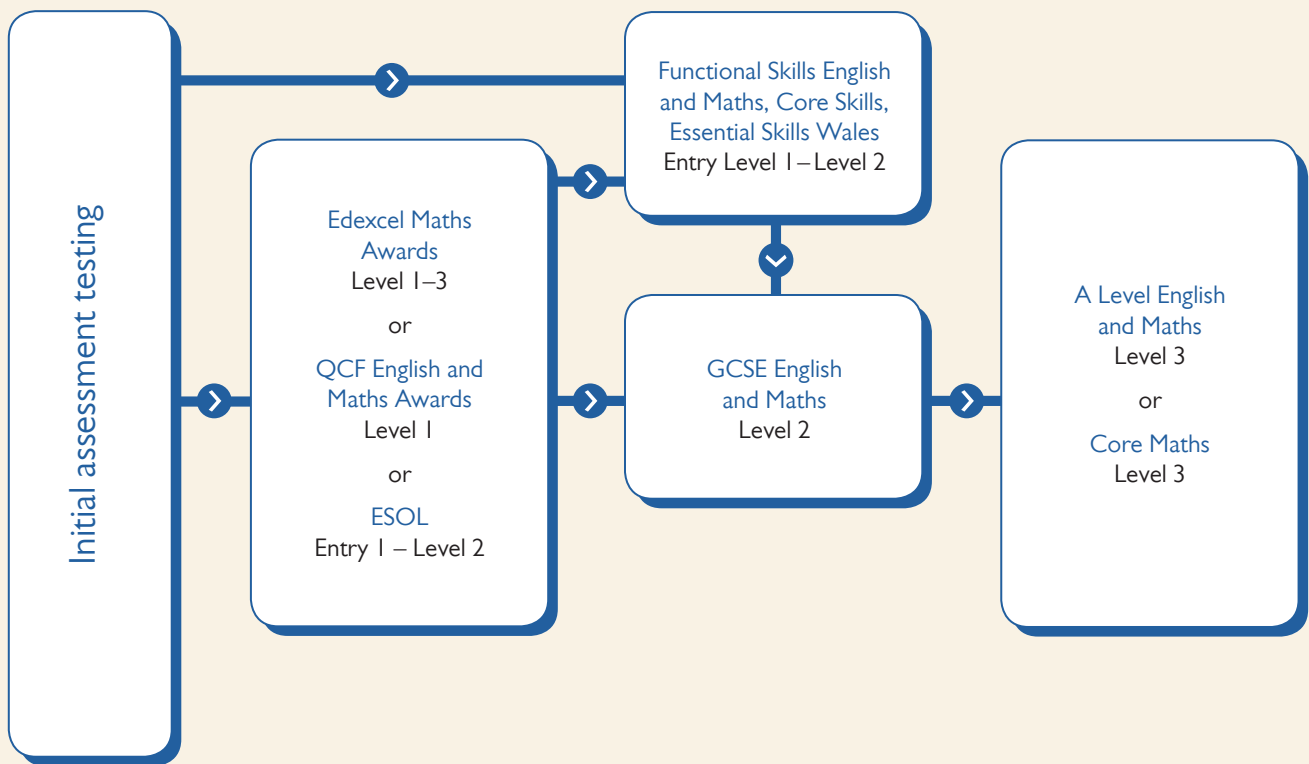


Post 16 English and mathematics mapping



- Learners start by completing initial assessments in English and mathematics
- This enables tutors to establish where a learner's skills set is at and which skills need to be worked on to enable them to progress to the next level.
- The tutor can then decide the best way to address those skills gaps be it for English – ESOL, QCF English Awards or straight onto Functional Skills English or for Mathematics – Edexcel Maths Awards, QCF Maths Awards or straight onto Functional Skills Mathematics.
- Once a learner has filled their skills gaps and passed their qualification/s they can either start progressing onto Functional Skills or GCSE English and mathematics depending on how they completed their skill gaps and the level they are at.
- Once achieving a GCSE Level 2 qualification, they could progress onto A Level or Core Mathematics if they wish.
