Competition Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions apply to the Friday Fieldwork competition starting Friday 27th September and concluding Friday 1st November 2019.

By entering this competition you will be deemed to have read and understood these rules and instructions and agreed to be bound by them.

This competition is only open to teachers currently employed by schools in the United Kingdom (England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland).

To enter the competition you must:

1. Follow the Pearson Geography [@edexcel_geog](#) Twitter feed.
2. Post a photograph on Twitter featuring a Geography Fieldwork location using #fieldworkfriday and tagging [@edexcel_geog](#), including your school name and the location of the fieldwork (entries that do not include this information will be automatically disqualified).
3. Photo must be posted between 10am (BST) Friday 27th September and 10am (GMT) Friday 1st November 2019.
4. Encourage your followers to retweet your photo as the photo with the highest number of retweets by 10am each Friday during the competition (excluding Friday 27th September) will win the weekly prize. Each entry may only be awarded one weekly prize during the competition.
5. If your photo includes images of students you must have parental permission to use the image on social media **before** posting it. Pearson takes no responsibility for photos posted without permission granted.

There will be five prize winners. Winners will be selected based on the highest number of retweets for their photo or video by 10am each Friday (excluding Friday 27th September).
