

### Extra Time for GCE Candidates

Please be advised, for GCE qualifications, an application for extra time must be submitted using JCQ Access Arrangements online prior to the candidate's first examination.

Once the approval has been agreed, the table below illustrates how extra time should be applied during GCE Music Listening exams.

#### 6U03 and 6MU06

**With extra time up to 25% = 30 minutes to be applied only as follows**

Start CD
Play as normal
Immediately after final playing of excerpt for Q1, pause CD
Allow extra 3 minutes 45 seconds
Start CD
Play CD as normal, no pauses
Immediately after final playing of excerpt for Q2, pause CD
Allow extra 3 minutes 45 seconds
At end of examination allow an extra 22 minutes 30 seconds

**With questions read out and up to 25% extra time = 30 minutes to be applied as follows**

Start CD
After announcement 'Question 1', pause CD
Read out Question 1
Start CD
Immediately after final playing of excerpt for Q1, pause CD
Allow extra 3 minutes 45 seconds
Start CD. Let run as normal until start of Question 2
After announcement 'Question 2' stop CD
Read out Question 2
Start CD
Play CD as normal, no pauses
Immediately after final playing of excerpt for Q2, pause CD
Allow extra 3 minutes 45 seconds
At end, allow an extra 22 minutes 30 seconds
