### 1. Conducting set tasks

- Release date is the date on which tasks can be released to learners. Tasks that are printed and sent to centres in hardcopy will be sent in advance of this date and must be kept secure until the release date has passed.
- Where given, learners must complete work by the end of the window for supervised conditions. The submission deadline is the deadline for work to arrive at Pearson or the examiner (as appropriate to each task). The gap between the end of supervised conditions and the submission date is to allow for work to be collated, packaged and despatched.
- Where a task is shown with an AM or PM slot for the supervised period, the published starting time is either 9.00 a.m or 1.30 p.m. UK centres may start this period earlier than, or later than, the published starting time for the session without prior approval from Pearson. However, in order to maintain the security of the examination all candidates must start examinations scheduled for a morning session no earlier than 8.30 a.m. and by 9.30 a.m. and for an afternoon session no earlier than 1.00 p.m. and by 2.00 p.m., except where arrangements have been made for dealing with timetable clashes. No other departure from the timetable is permitted without the prior written approval of Pearson.

### 2. Conducting examinations

- Each examination must be taken on the day and at the time as shown on the timetable.
- The published starting time of all examinations for UK centres is either 9.00 a.m. or 1.30 p.m. Learners with more than one examination in a session should take these consecutively. A supervised break may be given between consecutive examinations.
- UK centres may start an examination earlier than, or later than, the published starting time for the session without prior approval from Pearson. However, in order to maintain the security of the examination all learners must start examinations scheduled for a morning session no earlier than 8.30 a.m. and by 9.30 a.m. and for an afternoon session no earlier than 1.00 p.m. and by 2.00 p.m., except where arrangements have been made for dealing with timetable clashes. No other departure from the timetable is permitted without the prior written approval of Pearson. Examination centres should refer to the JCQ publication 'Instructions for Conducting Examinations' in the first instance.
- UK based learners who take an examination earlier than the published starting time shown on the timetable must remain under centre supervision until one hour after the published starting time for that examination.
- UK based learners who take an examination later than the published starting time shown on the timetable must remain under centre supervision from 30 minutes after the published starting time for the paper concerned until the time when those learners begin their examination.
- When a change is made to the published starting time for an examination it is the responsibility of the centre to inform all learners affected by the alteration.
