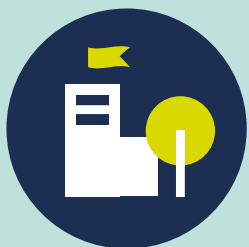

Notes: A CiDA/DiDA registration fee permits one attempt for each unit within that level. Any additional units, which may require to re-set, will be charged at an additional unit fee.

All entries received after the published entry deadline may attract a late entry fee or higher late unit fee. Please refer to the Information Manual for exact entry dates and further details. This can be downloaded from quals.pearson.com/infomanual

Candidates starting a CiDA or DiDA qualification must first be registered in order that unit entries can be made for them. For candidates intending to submit units in the January 2020 examination series, registration must be completed between 1 September and 21 October 2019. For all other September 2019 starters, registration must be made between 1 September and 15 November 2019.

Glossary

Ad hoc inspection fees

Please note that all centres will be subject to periodic ad hoc inspections during the conduct of the examinations. These are to ensure that the examinations are being administered correctly. Every effort will be made to minimise expenditure but the cost of these inspections will be re-charged to the centre by the inspecting authority as part of quality assurance.

Late Fees

We recognise how important it is for us to deliver your papers on time which is why we have a late fees policy to encourage all schools to make their exam entries as early as possible. The late fee charged, is based on the unit fee for the qualification. From the late fee date, the entry (unit or subject) fee is doubled. The entry fee is trebled after the high late fee date.

Changes to entries

You will not be charged a late fee for changing candidate details, such as name amendments unless a certificate has been issued. All tier or option changes will be classified as an amendment. For these cases the amendment deadline will apply.

Refunds

If you withdraw an entry before the high late fee date, you will be refunded the entry fee. After this date, you will not be issued with a refund unless you can provide supporting medical evidence that the candidate could not complete the unit/s.

Late cash-in fee

We will charge £3.90 for late requests for a subject award (cash-in) received after the entry deadline.

Requests for Retrospective Awards

We will charge £41 for late requests for a summer 2019 award (cash-in) made after the deadline for Review of Marking and Moderation; from 20 September 2019.

Certifying Statement of Results

A Certifying Statement of Results (CSOR) is an official copy of the final examination results held by Pearson. We can send a CSOR to candidates, educational institutions, professional bodies or employers who need us to confirm results. Payment of Fees

Fees due within 30 days from the date of invoice should be made payable by cheque, bankers draft or by bank transfer to Pearson.
