1 Introduction

1.1 GCSE reforms

From September 2012 all GCSEs have been linear (for two year courses). Furthermore, new GCSE specifications in English Language, English Literature and Mathematics have been available from September 2015 with first assessment in June 2017. New GCSEs in further subjects were introduced in September 2016 and September 2017 with first assessment from 2018.

1.2 Information on re-taking GCSEs, including controlled assessment

Candidates wishing to re-take a GCSE are required to re-take all written units in the qualification. All GCSE controlled assessment results can be carried forward from a previous series provided the controlled assessment contributed to a cash-in.

2.3 Retention of certificates

It is no longer necessary to return uncollected certificates to us. They may be destroyed (in a confidential manner) after retention for a period of no less than 12 months from the date of issue. Centres that do not have a means of destroying certificates confidentially may return them to us. A record of certificates that have been destroyed should be retained for four years from their date of destruction.

Centres must comply with any request from us to return a certificate. Certificates remain the property of the awarding bodies at all times.

2.4 Carrying forward controlled assessment results

All GCSE controlled assessment results can be carried forward from a previous series provided the controlled assessment contributed to a cash-in. Centres do not need to re-enter a candidate who has a controlled assessment result as the result will be carried forward automatically for all candidates cashing in. If candidates wish to re-take the controlled assessment unit the latest result will contribute to the final cash-in.
