## How do I use the Degree Course Finder (DCF)?

If you want to study in a specific country using your Pearson qualification – search by qualification.

Start out by going to the [homepage](#).

- [Click on the country tab and type the name of the country in the text box](#). A possible list of countries will appear that match your search. If the country you want does not appear, it means Pearson has not received recognition from a university in this country. Please [contact Pearson](#) if you require recognition in a certain country.

Or

- [Select a country on the map](#). If the country is orange, this means Pearson has received recognition from universities in this country. Please [contact Pearson](#) if you require recognition in a certain country that is not available.

- [Press search](#). A list of universities will appear in the country you have chosen.

- [Use the filter on the left side of the page to:](#)

- Find out which universities recognise your qualification.
- Find out which universities meet your criteria (size and setting).
- Find out which universities have the types of courses you're interested in (delivery method, entry point, and cost).

- [Click on a university name to find out more](#). This will either take you to the university's website (if they haven't provided Pearson with information about their institution) or will take you to the university's DCF profile page. Read as much information as possible about the university.

- [Click on "Show me courses"](#) or the Course tab at the top of the page to see what courses are available to you. If a university does not have any courses listed, this means they have confirmed recognition of your qualification, but have not provided Pearson with any particular progression routes. The best thing to do is to contact the university directly.

- [Click on the course name to find out more](#). This will either take you to the university's website (if they haven't provided Pearson with information about their institution) or will take you to a course profile page. Read as much information as possible about the course before you decide to apply.
