Where can I find information on Pearson Associate roles?

Our Associates perform many different roles across many subjects, sectors and qualifications. You can [view a summary of Associate roles](#), including requirements and responsibilities.

How do I apply for a Pearson Associate role?

Our website advertises all [current vacancies](#). When you have identified the role you wish to apply for select *Apply Online*. If you have a Gateway account please enter your login details and you will be directed to the online application form. If you do not hold a Gateway Account select Register Now and enter your registration details. Once your account is set up you will then be able to access the online application form. .,

What criteria do you require to become a Pearson Associate?

Each role has [specific requirements](#) listed on the website and within the job description. Please select the role you are interested in for a more detailed description.

I live outside the UK, can I still apply?

The majority of our Assessment Associate roles are UK based. You can apply for a UK based role as long as you have a UK Bank Account, a NI number and are legally entitled to work in the UK. If you do not meet this criteria then you may only apply for our international vacancies. Please be aware that at the point of registering for a Gateway account you will need to choose from one of these options:

1. I have a UK bank account and am legally entitled to work in the UK
2. I am applying for an international vacancy and located outside UK

If you select option 1 you will be eligible to apply for our UK based roles and if you select option 2 you will be eligible to apply for our international vacancies. It is not possible to be considered for both UK and International roles.

I work for other Awarding Organisations, can I still apply?

Yes, working for any other Awarding Organisation does not preclude you from applying for any non-senior role (for example; examiner, moderator, standards verifier). If you are

applying for a senior role (for example; chief, chair, senior standards verifiers) and currently hold a senior role with another Awarding Organisation then this may constitute a conflict of interest however.
