

## Learner Exam Conditions Checklist

Are you ready to take your assessment at home?

Take a few minutes and go through the checklist to make sure....

- ✓ You have informed your centre of any access arrangements you require – including that you wear hearing aids if applicable.
- ✓ You have returned your remote exam declaration to your centre
- ✓ You have successfully installed the Pearson Test Player
- ✓ You have successfully installed the video conferencing app specified by your centre on your second device which has a working camera and microphone
- ✓ Your laptop/desktop & second device are fully charged, or are connected to the charger, for the duration of the exam
- ✓ Where possible you have put your smart phone on do not disturb - only if this does not interfere with the video conference
- ✓ If you are using another device, such as a tablet, for the video conference your mobile phone is switched off and not present in the room where you will be taking your exam
- ✓ You have your photographic ID
- ✓ Your room is well lit
- ✓ Your desk space is clear
- ✓ You have no food on your desk
- ✓ Any drinks must be in a glass or a transparent bottle with all labels removed
- ✓ You are alone – there is no one else in the room with you and people you live with are aware not to enter the room for the duration of the exam
- ✓ You are not wearing any earphones or headsets
- ✓ You have been to the toilet – breaks are not permitted during the exam
