Login with your student ID and password provided by your school or college mocks administrator

You'll be asked to change your password at first login. If you forget your password, please contact your mocks administrator who can reset it for you.

! Important! Take a short test to practice

Take this test to practice before your Pearson Edexcel mock exam.

Use your student login for your practice test AND your actual onscreen mock exam.



You can use the zoom functionality and you have the option to change font size and background colour.

On the day of your onscreen mock

- There's a 15-minute pre-test practice built into the mock exams. You can submit the pre-test before the 15 minutes if you're ready to start sooner.
- The links you'll need for your mocks will be given to you by your school or college mocks administrator.
- You'll have **100 minutes** to complete your mock exams once you've logged in and completed the pre-practice test.
- There will be a timer onscreen, so you'll know how long you have left to go. You'll get a 10-minute warning before the end and the test will submit automatically when time runs out!



If you want to show your working out for marking, you'll need to show it onscreen.
