# Who can submit nominations?

- Teachers
- Tutors
- Heads of Department
- Heads of Year
- Principals
- Assistant/Deputy Principals

Unfortunately, we're unable to accept nominations from parents or learners. We recommend you speak to a teacher or head of department who can help on your behalf.



# Who can I nominate?

### You can nominate:

- any BTEC learner above the age of 14 that has taken a BTEC qualification and graduated within the years 2021-2022
- any BTEC teacher or tutor that teaches a BTEC qualification
- eligible schools that offer at least 1 BTEC subject.
- eligible colleges that offer at least 3 BTEC subjects and 3 BTEC levels

You can nominate as many BTEC learners and colleagues as you like.

A learner or colleague can only be nominated once – please do not submit nominations for the same nominee twice.









# Nomination Form Changes


The nomination process has been made as simple as possible this year - with only four steps needing to be completed:

- 1. Fill in some housekeeping questions about the nominator (yourself) and nominee
- 2. Tell us why your nominee deserves an award
- 3. Have your nominee answer some questions and
- 4. Submit your BTEC Award nomination!

This year we have a **save and resume function** so if you need to come back to your submission later you can!

# Learner Award Questions



# **Nominator questions**

This is your chance as the nominator to tell us why your nominee (learner) is a shining example of vocational excellence.

- 1. Tell us, in no more than 100 words, why your learner is outstanding. Give us examples of their dedication and commitment to their studies.
- 2. Tell us, in no more than 100 words, how your learner displays independent thinking.
- 3. Tell us, in no more than 100 words, what makes your learner a role model to others.
- 4. Tell us, in no more than 200 words, what others (teachers, peers, assessors, etc.) say about the learner? Use this opportunity to provide us with quotes from those linked to the learner's study that demonstrates they are a well-rounded individual.

# **Nominee Questions**

This is your nominees (learner) chance to tell us why they believe they are a shining example of vocational excellence.

- 1. In no more than 100 words, tell us why you choose to study your BTEC course and what makes you passionate about the subject?
- 2. In no more than 100 words, tell us how your BTEC course is helping you to prepare for your future?
- 3. In no more than 100 words, tell us how are you a role model to others within your school, college, or local community?
- 4. What are your successes and achievements (over and above your studies) inside or outside of school or college?

# **Nominator Questions**

This is your chance as the nominator to tell us why your nominee (teacher or tutor) is a shining example of vocational excellence.

- 1. In no more than 200 words, tell us why your nominee is an exceptional teacher/tutor. How do they enrich experiences for colleagues, learners and their centre in order to achieve positive results?
- 2. In no more than 200 words, tell us how your nominee brings their BTEC subject to life both inside and outside the classroom. Please provide examples of your nominee's enthusiasm and energetic teaching and learning style (using past experiences and resources at their disposal).

# **Nominee Questions**

This is your nominees (teacher or tutor) chance to tell us why they believe they are a shining example of vocational excellence.

- 1. In no more than 250 words, tell us what inspiring teaching tactics have you implemented to deliver your BTEC subject and how does it engage and motivate your learners? Provide examples of learner results and their improvements.
- 2. In no more than 250 words, tell us how have you supported/impacted your school/college on a wider level outside delivering your BTEC subject?

# **Nominator Questions**

This is your opportunity as a nominator to tell us how and why your nominee (educational establishment) is a shining example of vocational excellence.

- 1. Tell us in no more than 250 words, how your centre brings BTEC qualification(s) to life inside and outside of the classroom?
- 2. Tell us in no more than 250 words, how your centre promotes BTECs as a pathway. How do you prepare your learners for their next step?
- 3. Tell us in no more than 300 words, about the ethos and culture at your centre and how it encourages your learners to thrive.
- 4. In no more than 500 words, tell us what a day in the life at your centre is like. Why do you regard your centre as excellent? Include statements from learners, members of staff and any other stakeholders associated with your school or college.



# Submissions

- We will not require any additional documentation / digital content etc to support your nomination.
  Please use your word count careful to explain why your nominee is exceptional.
- In the 'Learner' and 'Provider' nominations we ask that you provide quotes and feedback from peers to support your nomination and help us understand why they are exceptional.
- Judges are aware and have made allocations for the BTEC Awards being an international competition. English is not the first language for some nominators. Please do not panic about grammar or spelling within your submission if we have any questions or queries, we will reach out to you via email.

# Timeline

- Nominations for the BTEC Awards close 17.00 pm (GMT) on Friday 25 March 2022.
- Final judging panel commences 6 May 2022
- Nominators updated from 13 May 2022
- BTEC Awards take place 23 June 2022

There will be no requirement to submit additional information during the judging period.

All bronze and silver certificates awarded to nominees will be posted using the details submitted by the nominator the week of the BTEC Awards 2022. All gold award winners will receive their certificates at the awards ceremony in London (subject to COVID-19 restrictions).
