 Closing movements between moving parts can present a <u>tropping</u> hazard. Learning Aim A: Firstly I drew out my habure drawing onto paper. I taped the drawing onto the polly press block and then traced over the top using a pen I was careful not to press too hard as Explore trapping and refine using a \_pen \_\_\_\_ I was careful not to press too \_hast \_\_\_ as anything you press down will show on my print. Once I have gone around my \_design\_ with a pen I have to look underneath the drawing and then use a pen to press harder directly on top of the poly press. Once the lines are smooth and \_\_desp\_\_, the poly block is ready to use. I then put ink onto a piece of plastic and spread the ink up and down with a \_foller\_. Once the ink was spread \_eventy on the plastic I inked up the print block making sure I covered the whole block and the edges. I then selected a piece of \_columed paper to print onto. I turned the printing block upside down and placed the print block onto the coloured paper. I used a clean roller for pattern eye clothing ideas and produce a 1. Tie back long heir and cover loose clothing with Aprons or similar 2. Use only non-toxic, water based intermediate in the classroom.


3. No eating or <u>Architeng</u> in the classroom. design for a print. placed the print block onto the coloured paper. I used a clean roller to press hard onto the <u>back</u> of the printing block. Once I have pressed down on all the areas of the print block I can peel off the print from the block and allow my print to <u>day</u>. I can now do the Aprons drinking hands same process and use different coloured papers to print onto. Once I have finished I can then wash off the  $\frac{10k}{100}$  from the print block. if inks or solvents get onto skin — Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water or use a skin cleanser. Do not use solvents.

The leaf design goes well with this cushion because it is a real leaf and it looks really nice .i think a old person who likes nature would want this cushion.


