Ensure your Edexcel Online accounts are up to date \square

At the start of term, we'll be asking your head of centre to work with you and sign a confirmation declaring all your Edexcel Online accounts are up to date. We'll also be working with your quality nominee to complete your annual quality declaration, so you'll need to make sure they have an Edexcel Online account with the quality nominee box ticked.

Request post-results and appeals

You have until the 26 September to make any post-result requests following the release of results in August. Once you receive the outcome of your request you have 10 working days to submit a formal appeal.

New registrations should be made for learners by 1 November. If you have learners that have already certificated and are moving on to a larger sized qualification you will need to make a top-up.
