<p>Unit 3: Care and Support Planning in Health and Social Care</p> <p>How long: 8 hours supervised time over the course of a week</p> <p>Creating the task: Learners create a care plan based on a set of case notes. They must produce an introductory service letter, explanatory leaflet and a detailed care plan.</p>	<p>Unit 5: Enquiries into current research in Health and Social Care</p> <p>How long: 3 hours supervised time over the course of a week; pre-release material available 6 weeks in advance.</p> <p>Creating the task: Learners use pre-release material and their own research to produce a Research Commentary.</p>

Internal assessment

Internal assessment is still the cornerstone of the BTEC learning experience.

It's used for some mandatory units, and all optional units.

Key points to note

- One resubmission allowed.
- Resubmission time limit is now 15 working days (increased from 10).
- Learner feedback rules apply.
- Assignment tasks should cover all assessment criteria within a learning aim.

Synoptic assessment

Students show they can draw on and apply skills and knowledge from right across the qualification.

<p>Unit 6: Meeting Individual Care and Support Needs</p> <p>Learners complete reports relating to the care and support provided for individuals which draw together how underpinning values and principles are applied through working practices, including multi-disciplinary working. Learners complete the reports using knowledge and understanding from their studies of the sector and apply both transferable and specialist knowledge and skills.</p> <p>180</p> <p>360</p> <p>510</p>	<p>Unit 5: Enquiries into Current Research in Health and Social Care</p> <p>Learners complete a research commentary based on a pre-released article and their secondary research, drawing together their knowledge and understanding of working practices and provision of services. Learners complete the task using knowledge and understanding from their studies of the sector and apply both transferable and specialist knowledge and skills.</p> <p>In delivering the unit you should ensure that learners understand that the assessment will draw on the content from across the specification.</p> <p>720 AC</p> <p>1080</p>
<p>Unit 3: Care and Support Planning in Health and Social Care Practice</p> <p>Learners complete activities related to planning care and support for an individual. Grading

Headlines

- **Compensation**
Students don't have to pass every unit to pass the course.
- **New "N" grade for externally assessed units**
New grade in between Pass and Unclassified ensures students narrowly missing a Pass still gain points towards the overall grade.
- **Students don't have to pass "the Core"**
Unlike BTEC Firsts, students don't have to pass "the Core".
