- 1 Sophie wants a new bathroom.

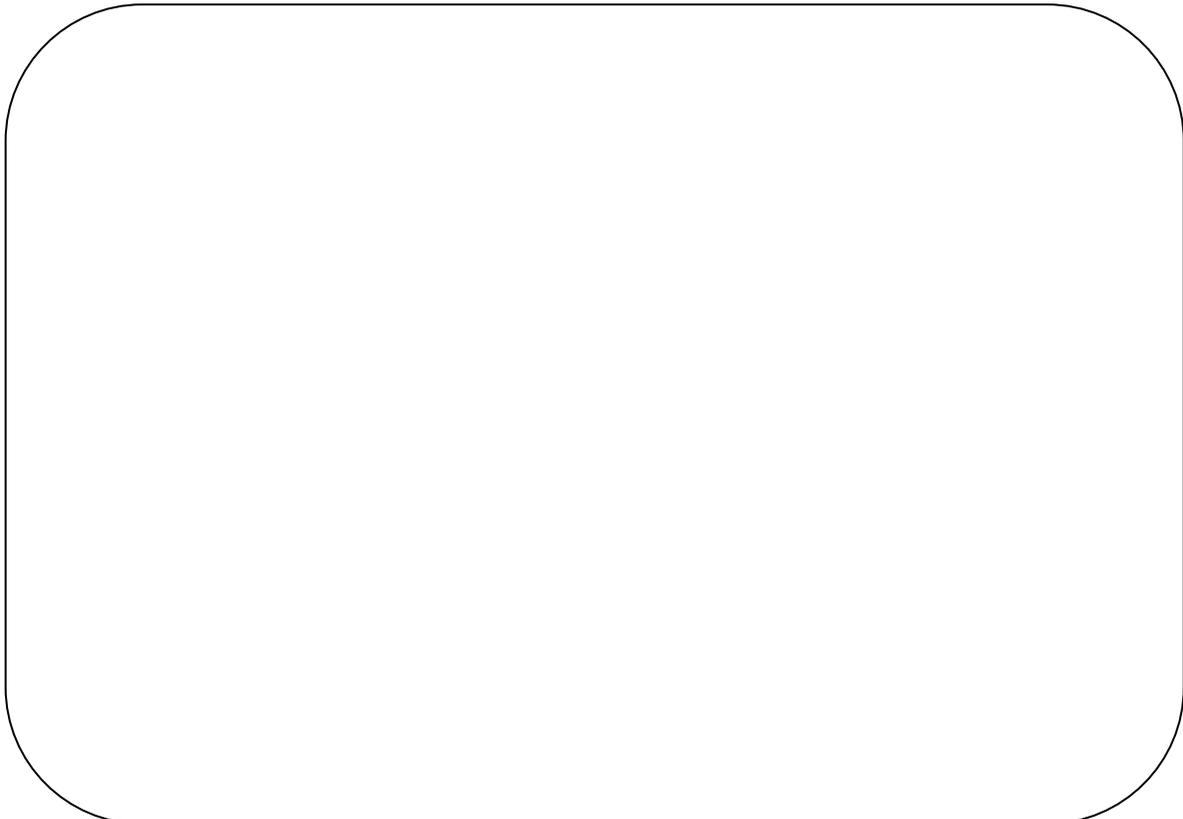
She wants to buy a new basin, a bath and a toilet.

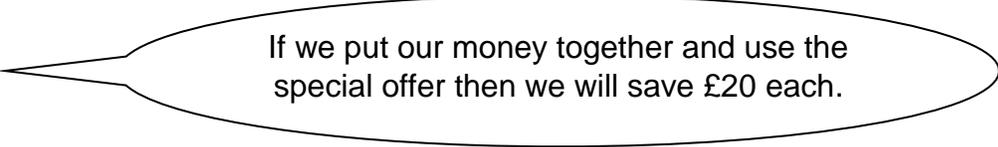
