OUR EPA

This level 3 EPA consists of three assessment methods, Multiple-choice test, Demonstration of practice, Professional discussion underpinned by a portfolio of evidence. The standard is typically designed as a 12 - month programme (this does not include EPA period) and is for apprentices working in healthcare, community or voluntary settings as Health Trainer, Care or Service Navigator, Social Prescribing Link Worker, Live Well Coach, Community Connector, Community Health Champion or Community Development Worker. We are looking at innovative ways to make the EPA a great experience for the learner without impacting their day job and whilst allowing them to perform to the highest level.
