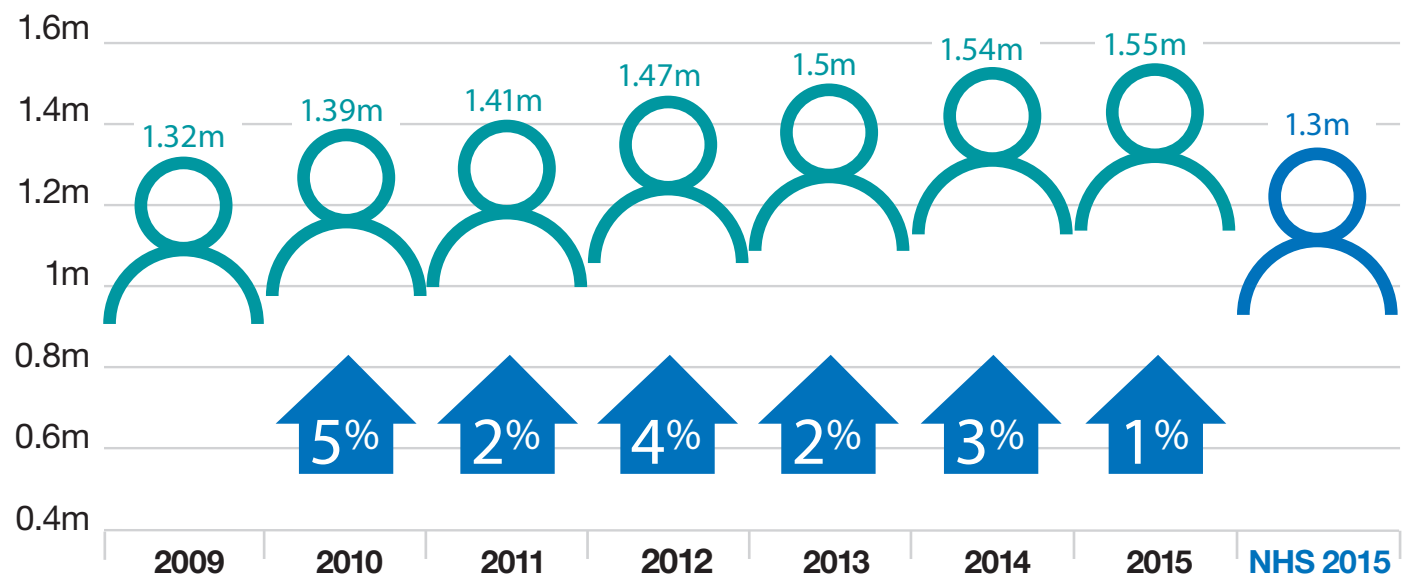


Adult social care jobs in England: **1.55 million**

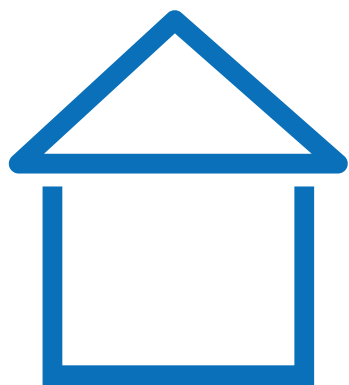
