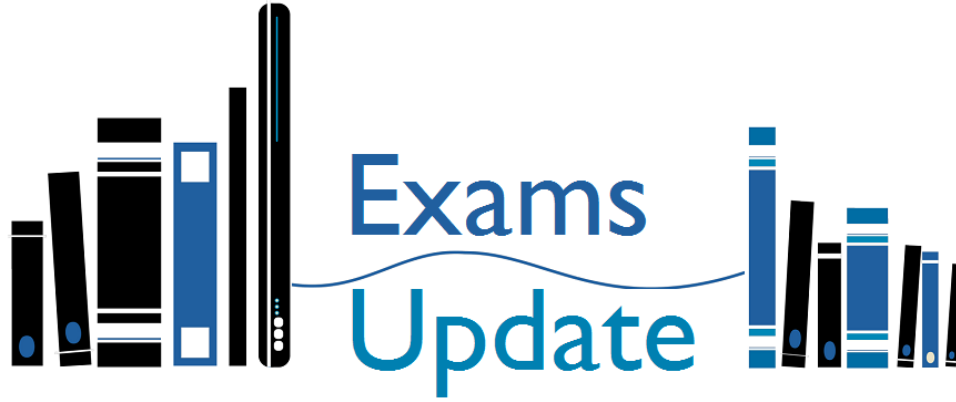

## BTEC NQF Test Entries for November 2014 and January 2015



The registration deadline for the 2014/15 academic year programmes is 1 November 2014, but the entry deadlines for the November and January test series are 4 and 21 October respectively.

Therefore, if you wish to enter first year learners for tests in November or January, please register them first as we cannot process any test entries until learners have been registered.

From this year, the November GCSE exam series is only available for candidates re-sitting **English, English Language and Mathematics**.

Please note that only candidates that have completed and been issued with a result in these subjects can be re-entered in the November 2014 series. A candidate who has previously sat English may be entered for English Language and vice-versa.

Marks for controlled assessment and the Speaking and Listening endorsement for English and English Language can be carried forward from previous exam series as long as they have been "cashed-in" for a subject award. If you would like to use results from previous series, you do not need to make unit entries for the relevant papers and the marks will be carried forward automatically. Please note that controlled assessment marks cannot be transferred between different awarding organisations.

**Please make sure that you submit your entries for the November 2014 GCSE exam series by the entry deadline of 4 October 2014.**
