Release of March 2014 next generation BTEC (NQF) External Assessment Results

Results for the March 2014 series have been released this morning on Edexcel Online for the following units:

- 20460E - Principles of Science
- 20474E - Scientific Skills



JCQ EDI results files have been issued to centres that made their bookings via EDI.

Results may be released to learners today.

The deadline to submit Enquiries about Results is 15th May, and 29th May for Access to Scripts.

On receipt of results for units 20460E and 20474E, learners may decide that they would like to re-sit in the June 2014 assessment window. If so, you have until 30th April to enter them for re-sits of these units before late fees will be charged.

You will also be able to withdraw June bookings for these units up until 30th April and receive a full refund.



High Late Fee deadline for June 2014 exams series

Please note the deadline to withdraw entries from the June 2014 exams series, and receive a refund of entry fees, is 21st April 2014.

Any entries received after the 21st April will be subject to high late fees.

Reminder GCSE Entries for June 2014

Students entering for the first time

All required unit codes and respective cash-in code need to be entered, in order to receive a final overall grade.

Students resitting a GCSE

Only controlled assessment unit(s) which have been certificated can be carried forward from previous exams series. All externally assessed units



must be entered alongside the respective cash-in code.
